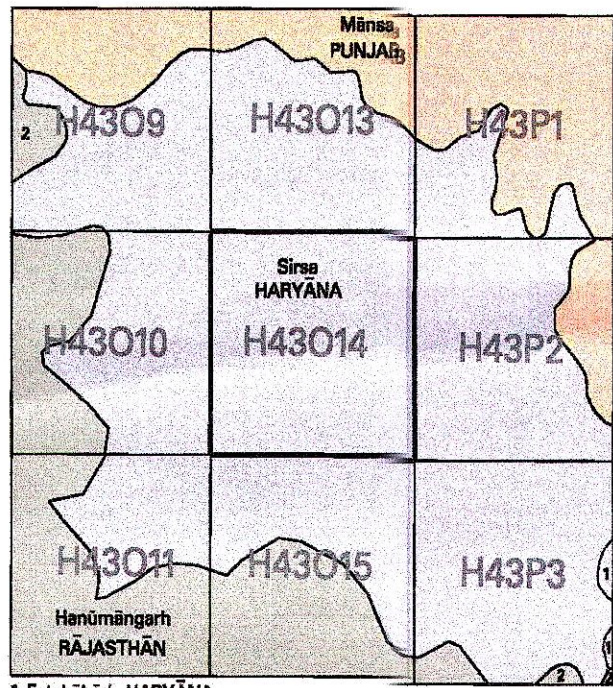

NOTES

A relative height, e.g. 2, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.

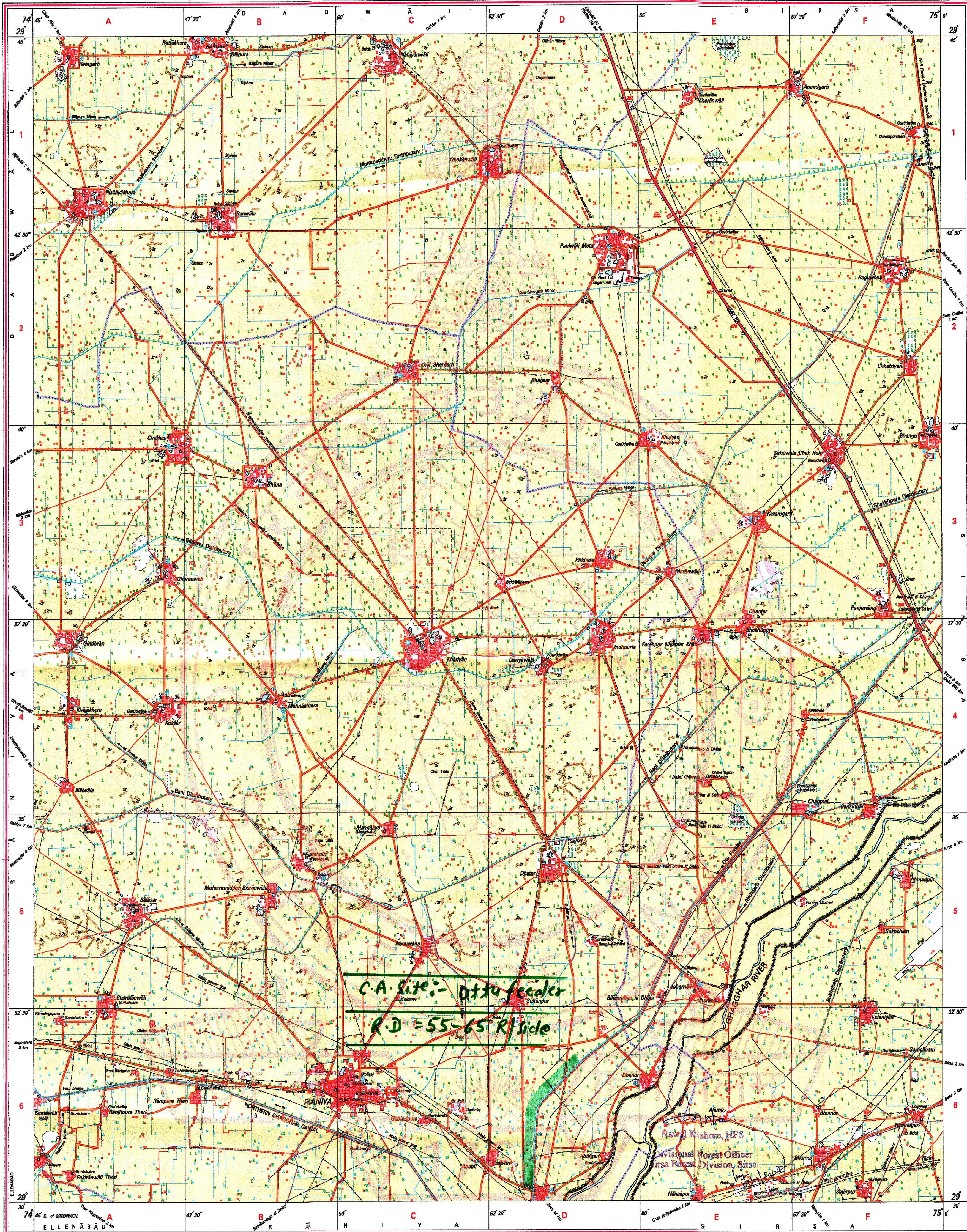
