**DEMAND NOTICE**

**Sub :** Diversion of 0.18 ha. of Forest land in Bandigani village Sy.No. 21 of Teradal Hobli, Jamkhandi Taluk, Bagalkote District for laying of Raising Main Pipeline (1.32m dia) under Sri Venkateshwar Lift Irrigation Scheme in favour of Executive Engineer, KNNL R & R Division Athani, Belagavi District.

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In cited above subject ref (1), Stage-I approval sanctioned for the Sri Venkateshwar Lift Irrigation Scheme from Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change Regional Office (South Zone), Bengaluru. And instruction received from reference (3) for issue the demand notice to user agency. Hence as per reference (1) of condition no. 3 of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (Central), MOEF & Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Bengaluru for payment of Net Present Values and Compensatory charges is as follows.

Therefore, you are hereby requested to make payments through online of forest clearance portal "[forestclearance.nic.in](http://forestclearance.nic.in)" as directed by the Government of India as per the demand notice issued by this office by uploading the demand notice for acceptance to The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force), Bengaluru and after getting the challan generated from the said portal.

You are directed to comply the following conditions as per reference No. (1) and (2)

1. Legal Status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency before Stage-II under the supervision of the Forest Department.
3. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
4. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred /deposited to CAMPA fund only through (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
5. The State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in term of the Scheduled Tribes and Other traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, if any, on the Forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in it's letter No. 11-9/1998-FC dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 read with 05.07.2013, in support thereof.
6. If the pipeline is over ground, sufficient provision shall be made for essential movement of people and animals.
7. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
8. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
9. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
10. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than i.e. specified in the project proposal.
11. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.18 ha.
12. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
13. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
14. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
15. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wildlife.


After receipts of the above conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. The forest land shall not be transferred to the User Agency prior to the issue of final approval.



Completion of the payments, you are directed to upload compliance report for the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval dtd. 20-10-2020 issued by Deputy Inspector General of Forests (Central) Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Regional Office Bengaluru and (4) sets of hard copies submitted to this office for further needful action.
