Cart tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally measurable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.

Wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

Tanks shown dry in this sheet usually contain water from July to March.

A relative height, e.g., '67', marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.

Unmetalled roads along canal embankments, except the one along bankbank of Lucknow Branch (SARDA CANAL), are shown by cart-track symbol.
