

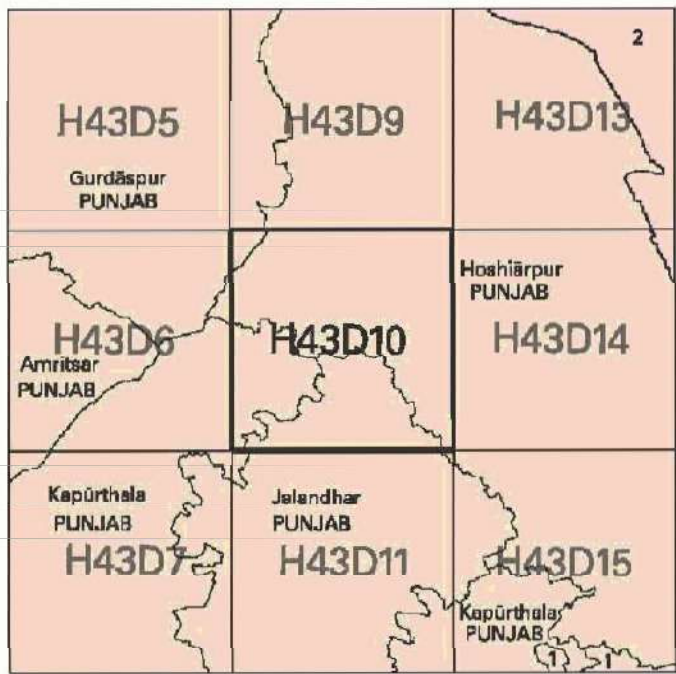

NOTES :-

Permission to use cartouches and unmarked words along roads is required from the irrigation authorities.
A relative height e.g. 40, marked along a road, indicates the height of the top of the road embankment above the adjacent country.
The area adjoining the Beas River is liable to orange owing to continual fluctuation in the source of the river.
Distance stones along protective embankments are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
Tanks shown on this map are usually built from July to December.
Tubewells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, e.g. 40, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

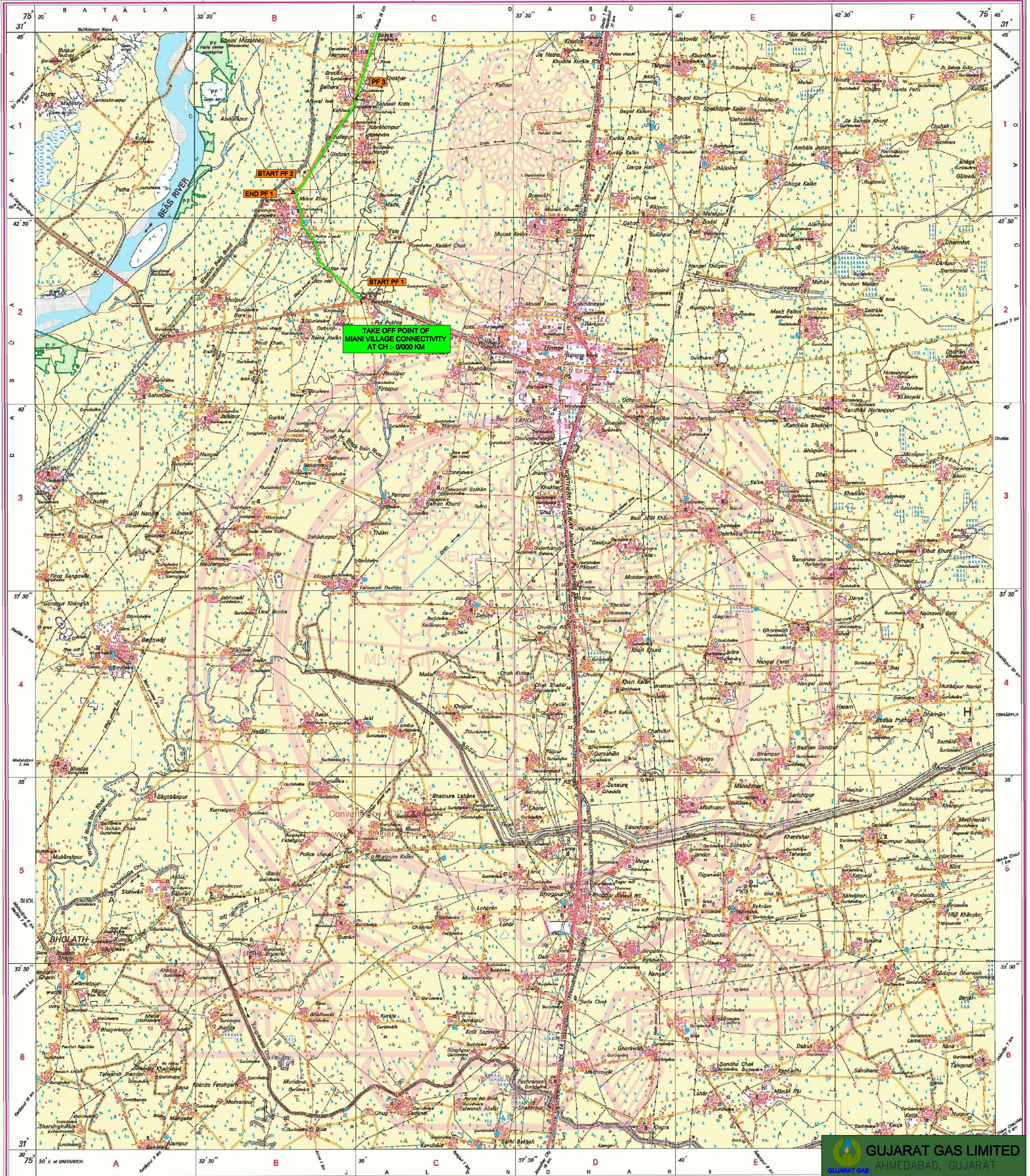

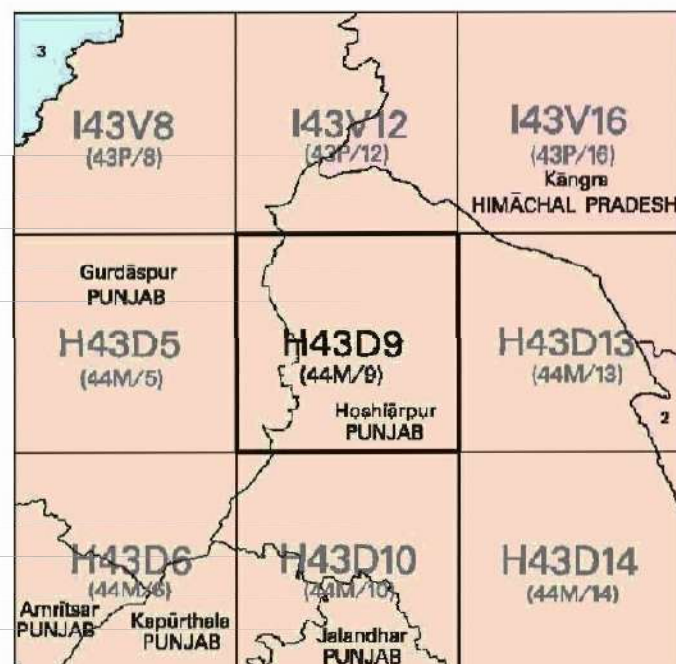

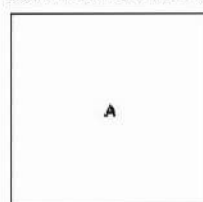

NOTES

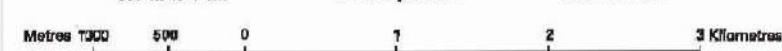

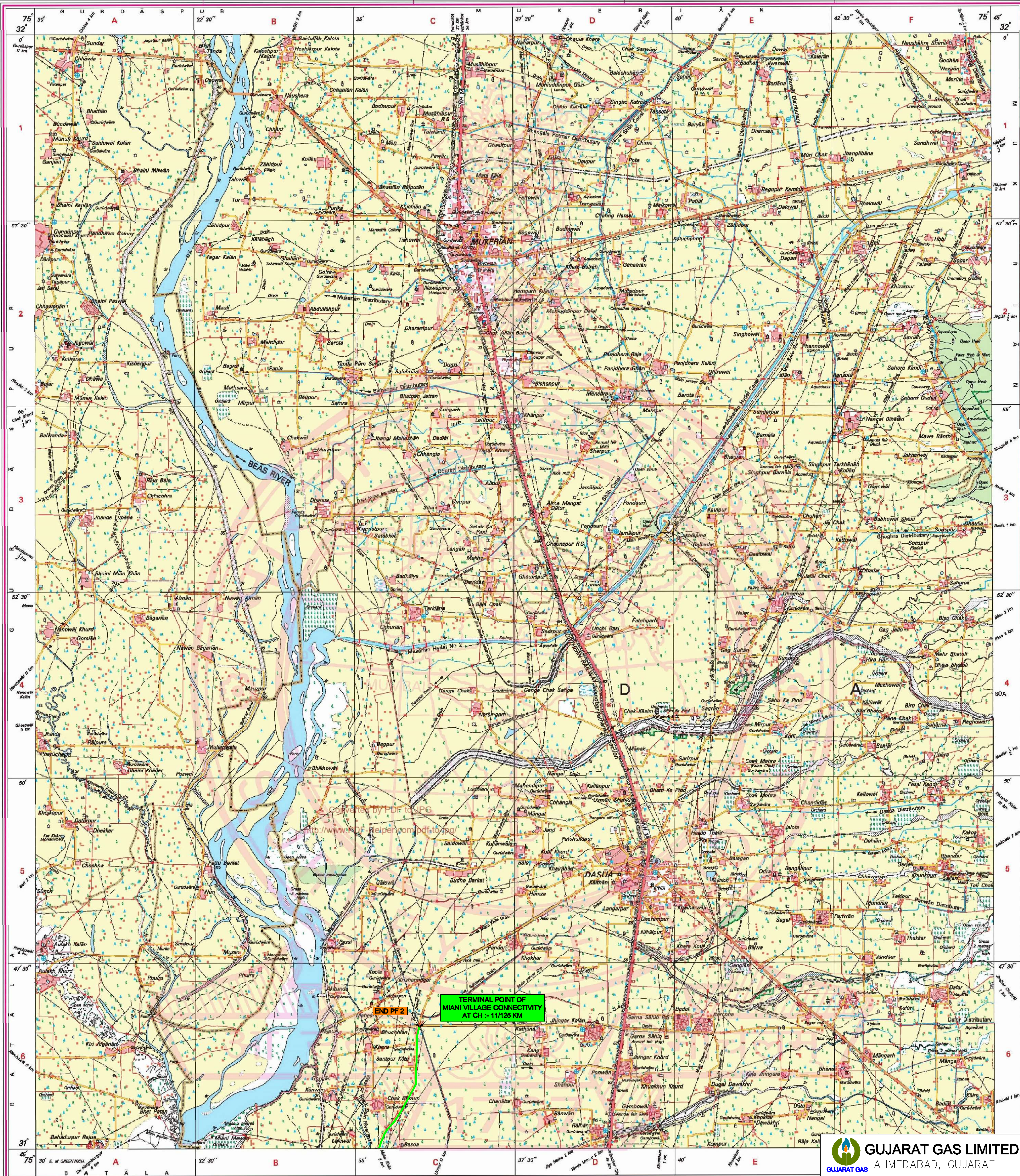
