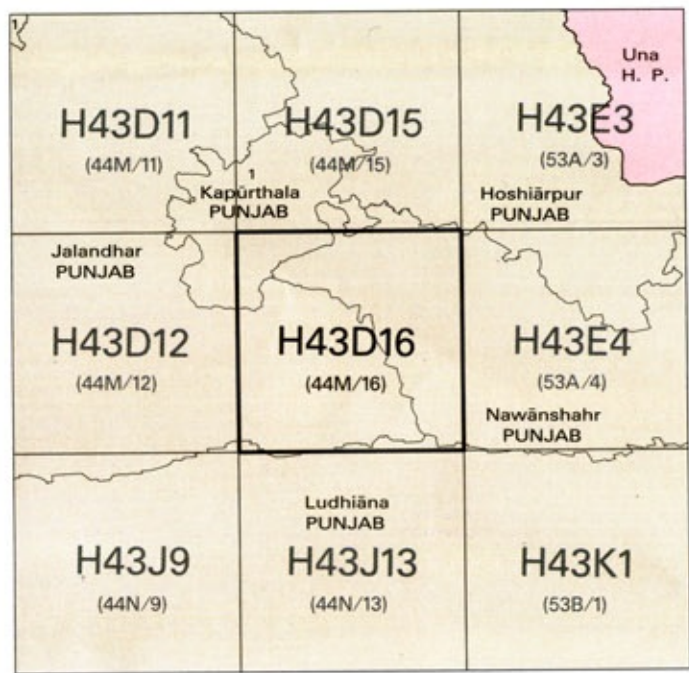

Heights and contours are not shown in this sheet.
Permission to use unclassified roads and cart-tracks along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
The course of the Satluj River is liable to continual change owing to shifting of the river bed.
Distance stones along canals are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height e.g., 3, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
A relative height, 3, represents the approximate height in metres between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

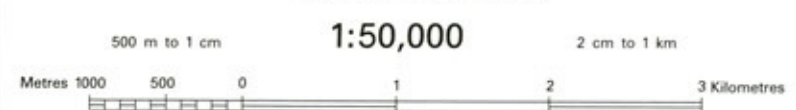

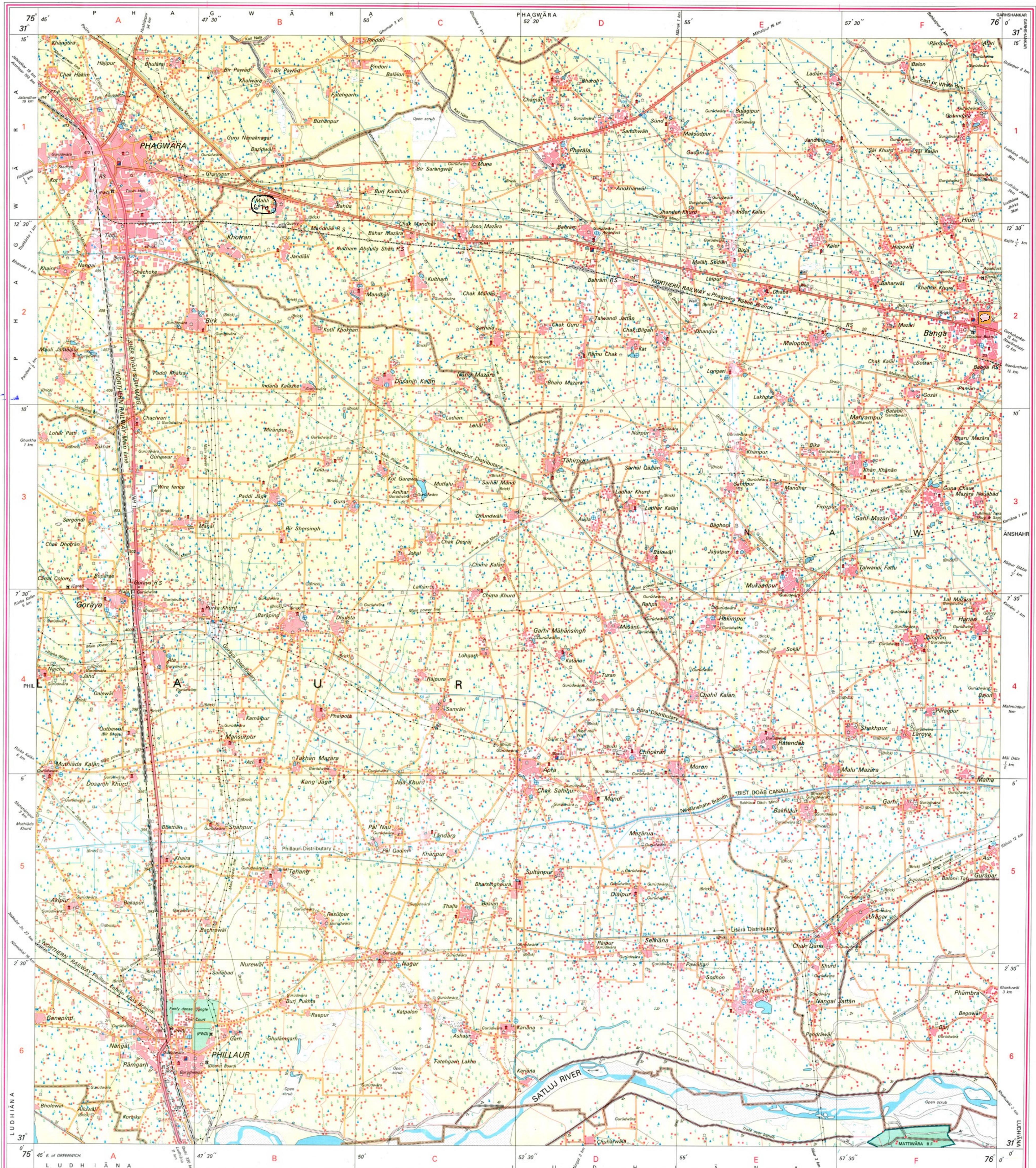
