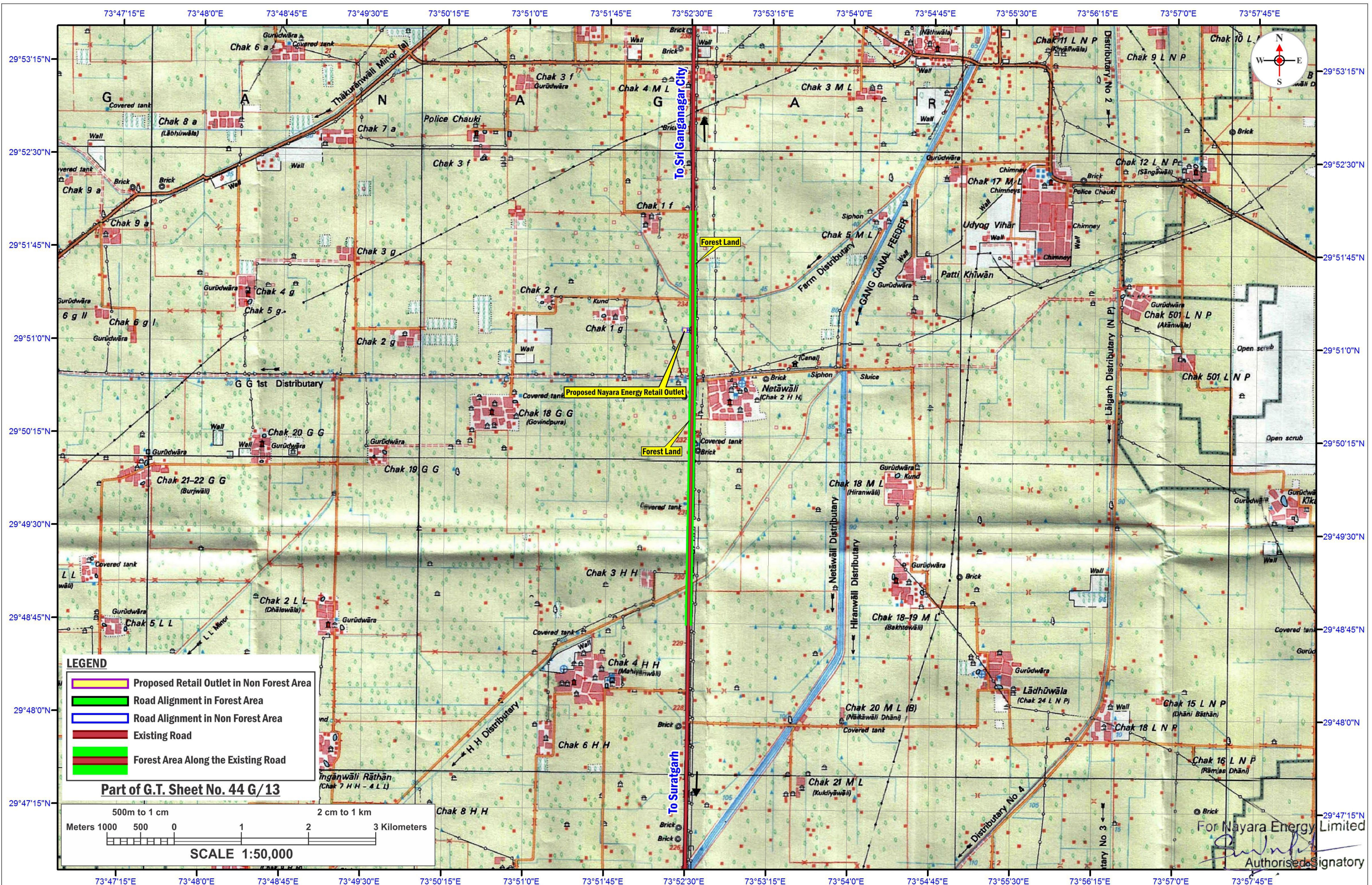

NOTES :-

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Canal distance stones are 1000 feet apart and every odding 10th stone is shown.
A relative height, e.g. 6, marked along a canal indicates the height of top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Permission to use unmetalled road and cart-tracks along canal is required from Irrigation authorities.
Most of the unlined well symbols indicates open tanks called kundis, which contain collection of canal water.
The state boundary between Punjab and Rajasthan state has been surveyed as pointed out by local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Governments concerned.
A relative height, e.g. 6, represents the approximate height in meters, between the top and bottom of steep slope.
Heights and Contours have not been shown.
Important buildings are shown in black.
International Boundary in the adjoining sheet in Administrative Index has not been shown.

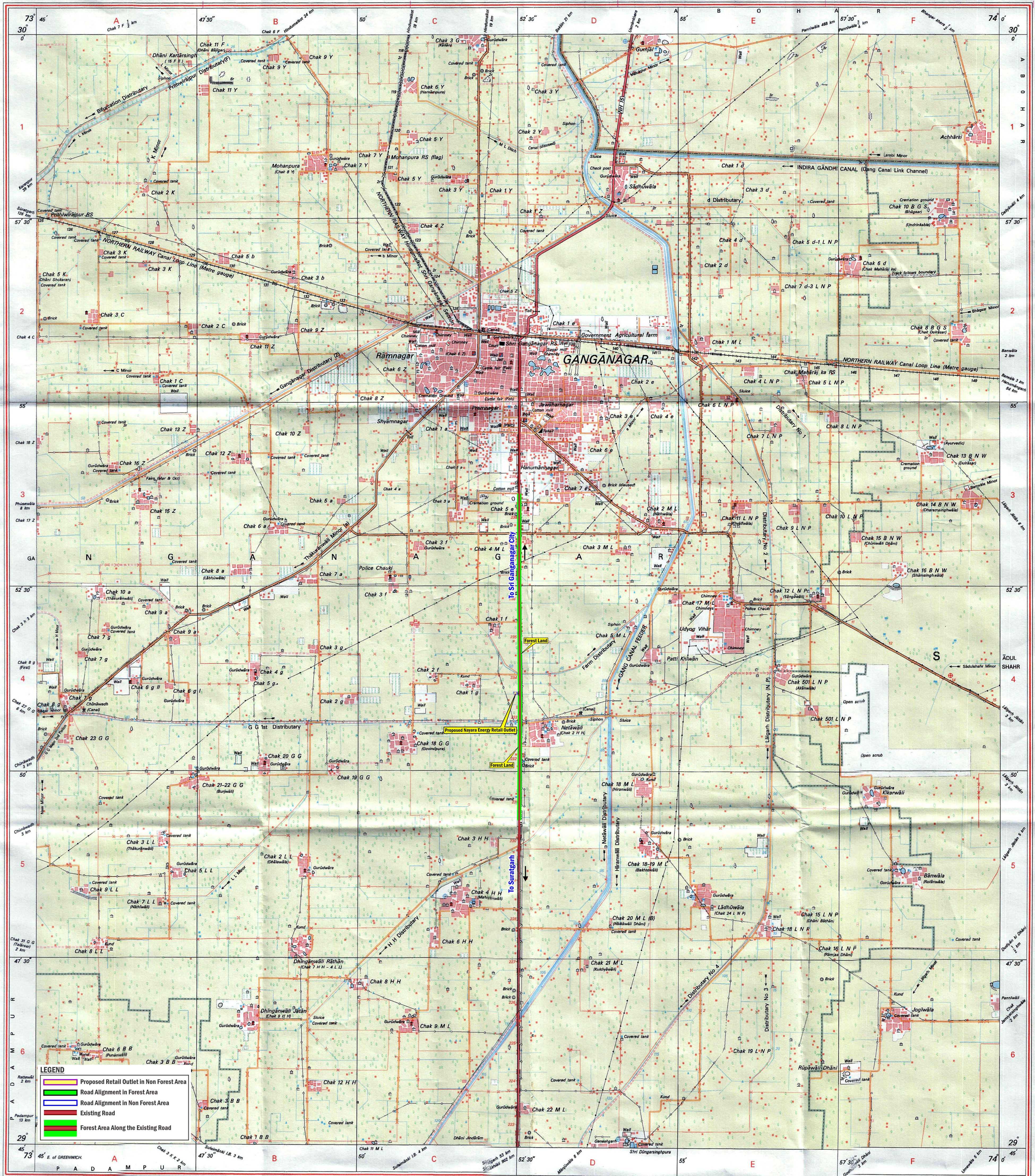
