
**TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN**

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests(MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-

FC(pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Schedule Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ("FRA" for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 7.8104 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Principle Government engineering college (name of user agency) for Construction of Government engineering college (purpose for diversion of Forest Land) Survey No.01 in Ramangara district falls within jurisdiction of Doddamannugudde village(s) in Ramanagara tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 9.20 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s) Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure 01 (secretary of Belagumba grama panchayathi letter no:gra pam, sam 05/2019-20 dated:04-04-2019) to..... annexure.....
- The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who eligible under the FRA.
- Each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that the formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of (secretary of Belagumba grama panchayathi letter no:gra pam, sam 05/2019-20 dated:04-04-2019) village(s) is enclosed as annexure 01 to annexure.....
- The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- The rights of primitive tribal Groups and Pre-Agriculture Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA
