



In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 111.05 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Manipur State Power Company Limited for the Construction of 132KV Transmission Line from Kakching to Moreh in Chandel Districts falls within jurisdiction of villages i.e Kuraopokpi, Laiching, Aimol Khulen, Saivom, Tengnoupal, Chahmol, Khongkhang, Tupi Mate, Khudengthabi, TM. Zoumunnom (main village S. Khudenthabi), L.Phaimoul (main village N. Champhai) Seivangkho (main village N. Champhai), New Mongjang, L. Youjang, T-Lhangnomphai (main village K. Mousang) and Haijangveng(main village K. Mousang) Villages.
