


JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING 132 kV LINE FROM  
KAKCHING TO MOREH IN FOREST AREA

The new 132 kV line to be erected from Kakching to Moreh (41.13 KM long) for supplying power to the new 132 kV substation coming up at Moreh passes through forest covering a total area of 111.05 hectares.

For stringing the line, 183 numbers of towers are to be erected along the route. While conducting survey of the route of the line, many alternatives routes were considered. The selected route is the shortest possible route with minimum disturbance to forest area.
