DEMAND NOTICE

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Sub:-Forest (Conservation) Act - Diversion of 3.713Ha of Forest Land in erstwhile Warangal (South) Division and presently Mahabubabad Forest Division - for laying of Pipe Line in Segment-17/1 (Nizam Cheruvu) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project - In favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal - Stage - I clearance accorded by Government of India - Compliance of GOI conditions - Issue of revised Demand Notice - Regarding.

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It is to inform that Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, region Office (South Eastern Zone), Chennai vide reference 7th cited has accorded In-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 3.713Ha of Forest Land in erstwhile Warangal (South) Division and presently Mahabubabad Forest Division for laying of Pipe Line in Segment-17/1 (Nizam Cheruvu) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal subject to the compliance of the certain conditions mentioned therein.

As per the conditions stipulated, the User Agency has to make the payment towards the following compensatory levels:

Out of the above, for Sl.No. 3 and 8 the User Agency has to deposit a total amount of **Rs.77,42,338/- (Rupees Seventy Seven Lakhs Forty Two Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty Eight only)**, the details are as shown in the below table), through e-payment portal only by generating challan at the Ministry's website (<https://forestsclearance.nic.in>) against the project into the Telangana Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) Saving bank Account maintained in the Bank mentioned below under intimation to this office with proof/evidence.

The payment has to be made in e-portal of forest clearances of MoEF GoI, New Delhi (<https://forestsclearance.nic.in>). The User Agency has to upload the demand at the e-portal of forest clearances for vetting by Nodal Officer, FCA, Telangana. After Vetting and acceptance by Nodal Officer, FCA, challan will be generated. Against the challan the payment has to be made. A step by step process for generating challan is available online at forest clearances portal.

Further, the User Agency is requested to pay the remaining amounts to deposit in favour of Forest Divisional Officer, Mahabubabad bearing A/c. No.62489787703, SBH, Mahabubabad IFSC: SBIN0020152.

Further, the User Agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the GoI instructions issued vide F.No.4-TSB058/2017-CHN/0258, dt:17.02.2017 at the cost of the Project proponent:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily news papers one in vernacular language and the other in English-granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal is also informed that, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest and, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the expert committee shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish and undertaking to this effect. The following conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval shall be complied with and condition-wise compliance report shall be furnished:

1. The legal status of diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 mts. At the cost of User Agency.
3. The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 3.713 ha out of the 187.677 ha of non-forest land identified in Sy.No.169 of Peddamunagala and in Sy.No.139 & 147 of Thimmapuram in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District at the cost of User Agency.
4. The State Government has proposed 3.713 ha of non forest land for Compensatory Afforestation under the subject proposal as part of 187.677 ha of non forest land identified for entire TDWSP

projects (Mission Bhageeratha Project). The CA land identified to the extent of 187.677 ha for the Mission Bhageeratha project at WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar shall be apportioned project wise including the CA area identified for the present proposal and all the relevant details like DGPS coordinates, amp, CA Scheme, soil suitability certificate etc., shall be uploaded in the Ministry's online portal against the subject proposal.

5. Identified CA land and approved CA scheme shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
6. Non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage-II clearance;
7. Non-forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation, shall be declared as Reserve Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section(s) of the local Forest Act. The Nodal Officer must report compliance within a period of 6 months from the date of grant of final approval and send a copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the local Forest Act as the case may be, to this office for information and record;
8. The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 3.713 ha from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos.826/In 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.
9. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest and if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency.
10. The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.
11. Trees standing in the diverted area shall be felled strictly as per requirement with prior permission of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.
12. The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.
13. The State Forest Department shall translocate the trees, wherever feasible instead of felling at the cost of user agency.
14. The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or subleased to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
15. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
16. Details of list of trees enumerated in the table designated for the same in part II of the online FC application may be uploaded and confirmation in this regard shall be reported along with the compliance report.
17. Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work should not destruct nearby forest flora and fauna.
18. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 3.713 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
19. User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
20. Any other condition that the Central Government or Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
21. The Progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the District Forest Officer, Warangal in Sl.No.12(v)(b) of part II i.e., 4.916 ha non forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Office to upload the same in the web portal.

22. In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

After receipt of the compliance on the above mentioned conditions the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of Forest land to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
