TO WHOSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forests Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 9.33 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, Amravati Project Construction Division, Amravati for Construction of Patiya Minor Irrigation Project in Amravati district falls within jurisdiction of Patiya village in Dharni tahsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 9.33 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), gram sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee (s), and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure-A-1 to A-3 annexure
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Chakarda, Kakarmal, Karda and Chourakund village is enclosed as annexure-B-1 to B-5 annexure
- (d) The discussion and decision on such proposal had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as requires under section 3 (2), of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it; Not Applicable As sec 3 (2) of FRA limits diversion to 1 Ha, whereas the current proposal is for 9.33 Ha.
- (f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA Not Applicable
