महोदय Sir.

In exercise of the power conferred by Government of India Order No- S.O. 1857 (E) dated18.05.2016. I hereby approve the aforesaid Review & Updation of Mining Plan (including Progressive Mine Closure Plan). This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Review & Updation of Mining Plan along with Progressive Mine Closure Plan is approved without prejudice to any other law applicable to the mine area from time to time whether made by the Central Government, State Government or any other authority and without prejudice to any order or direction from any court of competent jurisdiction.
- 2. The proposals shown on the plates and/or given in the document is based on the lease map /sketch submitted by the lessee and is applicable from the date of approval.
- 3. It is clarified that the approval of aforesaid Review & Updation of Mining Plan along with Progressive Mine Closure Plan does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provision of Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, or the Minerals (Other than Atomic & Hydro Carbon Energy Minerals) Concession Rules, 2016 and any other laws including Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 or the rules made there under, Mines Act, 1952 and Rule & Regulations made there under.
- 4. Indian Bureau of mines has not undertaken verification of the mining lease boundary on the ground and does not undertake any responsibility regarding correctness of the boundaries of the precise area as furnished by the lessee.
- 5. At any stage, if it is observed that the information furnished, data incorporated in the document are incorrect or misrepresent facts, the approval of the document shall be revoked with immediate effect.
- 6. This approval is restricted in respect of the proposals contained therein within mining lease area and is applicable from the date of approval for financial year 2018-19 to 2022-23 with a validity upto 31.03.2023 subject to all statutory compliance and clearances.
- 7. The Financial assurance shall be due for submission on 31.03.2023.

- 8. Adequate number of check dams & retaining walls shall be unde & maintained in good conditions to prevent any anticipated detrimental impact on water regime.
- 9. "Safety Berm" of adequate dimension shall be kept at all the places in the vicinity of statutory barrier, high bench/escarpment. It shall also be ensured that no excavation is to be made in the vicinity of any high side wall/escarpment. Stability of benches, escarpment shall be closely monitored. It is the responsibility of the lessee to ensure the stability of all the escarpments/sides/benches. Lessee shall take all necessary steps time to time so as to ensure the stability of ground, which includes, but not limited to, reduction of the high side wall to safe and stable condition within first year itself.
- 10. Sufficient safety Berm shall be maintained with respect to public road/village roads.
- 11. Controlled Blasting shall be carried out and Blast Hole shall be adequately muffled. Each and every blast shall be monitored for Ground Vibrations and Air over Pressure.
