Sir,

Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Regional Office, Nagpur conveyed the 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 2.9046 ha Reserved Forest land in favour of Maharashtra Jeevan Pradhikaran Division, Yavatmal for installation of Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) & Sewerages in Village- Pimpalgaon, Wadgaon Road and Umarsara, District- Yavatmal in the State of Maharashtra. The compliance report of the conditions of in-principle approval was furnished vide letter dt.31/03/2021 as under:-

a.	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 3.00 ha non-forest land in Gut. No. 63 at Village- Nanza, Taluka- Kalamb, Dist- Yavatmal. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Yavatmal District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided;	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 3.00 ha non-forest land in Gut. No. 63 at Village- Nanza, Taluka- Kalamb, Dist- Yavatmal. In this regard, the User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.21,90,159/- toward the cost of Compensatory Afforestation in Ad-hoc CAMPA Account. b.	The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval. A copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the State Forest Act as the case may be, will be submitted by the State Government prior to Stage-II approval;	Compensatory Afforestation over 3.00 ha. out of 10.42 ha. non forest land in Gut No.63 in Village Nanza, Tal. Kalamb Dist. Yavatmal the said land has been transferred on 25/08/2021 and handed over to Forest Department on 18/09/2021, RFO, vide letter dated 24/09/2021.
