It is submitted that the Government of India vide reference 6th cited has conveyed Central Government **in-principle** (Stage.I) approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 4.562 ha (Manuguru 4.160 ha + Paloncha 0.402 ha) under Bhadadri-Kothagudem District, for laying of Pipe line for Segment 25/3 (Burgampadu), for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report in the matter, vide reference 7th cited.

Accordingly, the District Forest Officer, Bhadadadri-Kothagudem has obtain compliance of conditions from the User Agency and submitted the condition-wise compliance report together with its enclosures through Conservator of Forests, Kothagudem, which is received in this office through reference 8th cited. A copy of reference 8th cited together with its enclosures **in triplicate** are enclosed herewith.

The condition-wise compliance report is reproduced with remarks as follows:-
