It is submitted that the Government, vide reference 7th cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 9.305 ha of forest land in Bhupalpally Division - for laying of Pipe Line and Construction of structures in Segment-15/1 (Konampeta) - for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project - in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Karimnagar. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report, vide reference 8th cited.

The CCF / Conservator of Forests, Warangal had obtained compliance of conditions from the District Forest Officer / Forest Divisional Officer, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District and User Agency and submitted vide reference 10th cited.
