With reference to your above mentioned letter on the subject forest land proposal it is to inform you that approved project cost of Konar OCP (8 MTY) is Rs. 799.34 crores whereas the estimated cost mentioned in the Form A is Rs. 1091.53 crores (the copy of approved project cost and Form A is attached). Further to inform you that the date of application for the subject forest land proposal is 17.06.2016 whereas project report (including project cost) of Konar Expansion OCP (8 MTY) was approved on 24.01.2022 by Coal India Limited Board.

Further to inform you that demand for Soil & Moisture Conservation Plan is raised on the basis of estimated cost mentioned in the Form A i.e. 1091.53 crores with reference to above mentioned letter no 3250 dated 19.11.2022.

Therefore it is requested that demand for Soil & Moisture Conservation Plan may be raised on the basis of project cost i.e. 799.34 crores mentioned in the project report of Konar Expansion OCP (8 MTY) approved by CIL Board on 24.01.2022, not on the estimated cost mentioned in Form A and hence the demand letter (letter no 3250 dated 19.11.2022) may be revised.

In view of the above and as recommended by Empowered Sub-Committee, Board accorded its approval for Revised Cost Estimate (RCE) of Rs.553.33 Crores for the Scheme on Coal Evacuation System by Belt Conveyors and dispatch through Rapid Loading System (RLS) with Surge-bin at Sardega Siding (20 MTY) as brought out in the agenda note.

- 4.24** Director (Tech.) apprised the Board that Expansion PR of Konar OCP (8 MTY, Peak capacity-11 MTY) including Mining Plan for a total capital investment of Rs.799.34 Crores (Existing Capital Rs.124.98 Crores + Additional Capital Rs.674.66 Crores) for implementation under Variant-IV (i.e. Coal & OB both Departmental in Eastern Quarry and Coal & OB Outsourcing in Western Quarry) was recommended in 115th meeting of Empowered Sub-Committee of CIL Board held on 10th January'2022 to be placed to Board for its consideration.

This is one of the identified projects under 1BT programme. The grade of coal in Seam X is Washery grade IV and that of Seam VIII & Seam VII & VI is Washery grade VI. To a query it was clarified that even if coal produced from this mine is marketed as G-10 grade instead of Washery-VI, the project is still viable as IRR at 85% capacity utilization under Variant IV (i.e Coal and OB both departmental in Eastern Quarry and Coal and OB outsourcing in Western quarry.) comes to Rs.86.65%.

Hence, as recommended by Empowered Sub-Committee, Board accorded its approval for Expansion of PR of Konar OCP (8 MTY, Peak capacity-11 MTY) including Mining Plan for a total capital investment of Rs.799.34 Crores (Existing Capital Rs.124.98 Crores + Additional Capital Rs.674.66 Crores) for implementation under Variant IV (i.e Coal and OB both departmental in Eastern Quarry and Coal and OB outsourcing in Western quarry) as brought out in the agenda note.
