Please find, enclosed, herewith a proposal seeking forest clearance for diversion of 0.0116 ha of forest land for installation of Automatic Data Acquisition & Real time data transmission system through Satellite for Rainfall Water Level & Snow measurement at 17th Mile Katao Gurudongmar Lake, Yumesamdong, Dombang, Thangu, Yumthang Valley, Dombang Zero, Lachung, Samdong, Zema and Lachen in Mangan Sikkim by Central Water Commission.

Brief Description:

The user agency has proposed for installation of Automatic Data Acquisition & Real time data transmission system through Satellite for Rainfall Water Level & Snow measurement at 17th Mile Katao Gurudongmar Lake, Yumesamdong, Dombang, Thangu, Yumthang Valley, Dombang Zero, Lachung, Samdong, Zema and Lachen in Mangan Sikkim after obtaining the forest clearance under the provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

The proposal has since been uploaded in the "OMFC" portal of the Ministry vide proposal No. **FP/SK/Others/146631/2021** and accordingly transferred to the level of MoEF, Integrated Eastern Regional Office at Kolkata through on-line mode.

The aforesaid degraded forest land is proposed to be brought under Afforestation programme as per the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme drawn by the Divisional Forest Officer, Mangan Territorial Division, with financial outlay of Rs. 24,934.00 (Rupees twenty four thousand nine hundred and thirty four) only (Enclosed at Annexure IX). The Compensatory Afforestation Scheme will be undertaken in the designated compact area identified by Mangan Territorial Division of Sikkim.

The Divisional Forest Officer (T) Mangan Division has given the certificate on suitability of degraded forest land for Compensatory Afforestation. (Annexure –X). Accordingly, the User Agency has furnished an granted by the Ministry in this respect (Annexure – XI). But no Penal Compensatory Afforestation has been imposed since no violation of the Act has been reported against.

- (ii) I have also examined all other relevant records.

On the basis of aforementioned joint certificates and examination of all other relevant records, I do hereby certify that non-forest land, revenue lands, zudpi jungle, chhotejharka jungle, bade jharka jungle, jungle-jhari land, civil-soyam lands and other such categories of forest lands (except the forest land under management and administrative control of the Forest Department) on which the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 are applicable, which as per the extant guidelines of the Central Government may be utilized for creation of compensatory afforestation in lieu of forest land diverted for non-forest purpose, are not available in the entire State of Sikkim.
