The proposal for diversion of 0.562 hec. of forest land for extension of Paradip-Haldia-Durgapur pipeline to Muzaffarpur and Patna from Durgapur Terminal in favour of Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL) under Birbhum Forest Division is the barest minimum needed for laying of underground oil pipeline in an economical way, and the said forest area does not inhabit any endangered flora/fauna.

The proposal has been recommended by the Divisional Forest Officer, Birbhum Forest Division and the Chief Conservator of Forests, South East Circle, West Bengal.

Hence, the proposal for diversion of 0.562 ha. of forest land is recommended.




