In inviting a reference to above cited letters, it is to intimate you that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Changes have accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 12.2282ha of forest area coming within jurisdiction of Bhadrak (WL) Division, Mangrove (WL) Division, Rajnagar, Khordh Forest Division, City forest Division, Bhubaneswar, Cuttack Forest Division and Dhenkanal Forest Division for laying of underground natural gas pipeline along with Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) of Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra Natural Gas Pipeline, Odisha Project by GAIL (India) Ltd. As per conditions in the approval letter, you are requested to deposit the following amount in State CAMPA fund in A/C No.520101263743655 of Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhia Road, New Delhi-110003 by e-payment module through <https://parivesh.nic.in> towards Net Present Value (NPV) pertaining to Bhadrak (WL) Division and transmit the acknowledgement receipt/ Challan to this office for onward transmission.

Further, you are also requested to comply following point wise stipulation made in the in-principal approval (Stage-I) letter to this office at an early date for taking necessary action at this end.

- (i) The user agency has to submit an undertaking not to change the legal status of proposed forest land to be diverted.

- (ii) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, the forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the projects is handed over to the user agency.
- (iii) The user agency should submit documentary evidence on compensatory afforestation.
- (iv) The user agency has to submit an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- (v) The user agency should submit Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan including Mangrove restoration duly approved by the Chief Wildlife Warden, Odisha.
- (vi) The user agency has to submit an undertaking to raise elsewhere at project cost ten times the number of trees to be felled in consultation with local DFO under intimation to Regional Office.
- (vii) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that the pipeline shall be laid down 1.2 meter below the ground as proposed by the State Govt. and after laying down of pipeline the ground will be levelled.
- (viii) The user agency has to submit an undertaking to implement intensive Soil & Moisture Conservation measures along both side of the proposed gas pipeline corridor passing through forest area at project cost.
- (ix) The user agency has to submit an undertaking to obtain necessary Environmental Clearance and other statutory clearance, if applicable before final forest clearance.
- (x) The user agency has to submit an undertaking the layout of plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- (xi) The user agency has to submit an undertaking in relation to the cost of expenditure like boundary wall, stones pillars, demarcation charges, charges for felling of trees and their transportation to depots shall be deposited with DFO concerned on demand before the diversion and handing over of the forest land takes place.
- (xii) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, no labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (xiii) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that they should provide LPG or alternate fuel, to labourers working at the site to avoid damage/ tree felling and ensure no fuel wood use.
- (xiv) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, no additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- (xv) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
- (xvi) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment & Climate Change.
- (xvii) Documentary evidence would be obtained in respect of settlement rights under Forest Right Act, 2006 on the forest land to be diverted as prescribed by Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Changes from District Collector, Bhadrak.
- (xviii) Any other conditions that Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of forest protection and development.

- (xix) The user agency has to submit an undertaking that, they should comply the provision of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- (xx) The user agency should comply with the conditions stipulated by State Govt. vide letter No. 10(Cons)155/2020-17699/F&E dated 11.11.2020.



With reference to the letter cited above on the captioned subject, it is to inform that the Govt. of India, MoEF & CC, Eastern Regional Office, Bhubaneswar vide letter under reference have accorded Stage-I approval for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra Pipeline (JHBDPL), Odisha Phase-I: Diversion of total 4.3262 Ha. land in Cuttack Forest Division for laying of underground Natural Gas pipeline along with Optical Fibre Cable(OFC) from Jagdishpur in Uttarpradesh State to Haldia in West Bengal through Bihar, Jharkhand & Odisha State- Pipeline laying through Reserved Forests/ Protected Forests falling in Cuttack & Jajpur Districts of Odisha State, subject to fulfillment of 26 nos. of conditions.

With reference to your letter cited above on the captioned subject, the revise demand against Compensatory Levis in connection with the above project is raised as detailed below.

The **Stage-I in-principle** approval order in connection with the above project has been issued vide No.5-ORC434/2020-BHU dt.03.11.2020 of the Government of India, MoEF& CC, ERO, Bhubaneswar with 26 conditions and additional 05 conditions has been imposed by the State Government vide No.FF-DIV-FLD-0041-2020-10F(Cons)155/2020-17699/F&E dt.11.11.2020 of the Government of Odisha, Forest & Environment Department which has been communicated to you vide Memo No.17703/F&E dt.11.11.2020 of the Special Secretary to Government, Forest & Environment Department which may be referred to.

As per Condition No.iii & iv in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order, 25.00 Ha. of Degraded Forest Land has been identified in Pachhikote DPF under Jajpur Road Range of Cuttack Forest Division. Accordingly, the compensatory Afforestation scheme has been technically approved for Rs.48,96,200/- vide Memo No.20973 dt.02.12.2020 of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FD & NO, FC Act) O/o the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Odisha, Bhubaneswar. The demand has been raised vide Memo No.10363 dt.04.12.2020 of the Divisional Forest Officer, Cuttack Division.

As per Condition No.v in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order, the State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the Forest Land proposed for diversion.

7. Forest area to be diverted for non-forest purpose -6.2592 Ha.
8. Density of vegetation is less than 0.4 (Eco value class-III)
9. Demand for NPV-Rs.6,26,000/- x 6.2592 Ha. = Rs.39,18,259.00

As per Condition No.ix in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order, the State Government shall charge Penal NPV equal to NPV of Forest Land per hectare for each year of violation from the date of actual diversion as reported by the inspecting officer with maximum upto five (5) times of NPV plus 12% simple interest till the deposit is made from the User Agency. In case of public utility project of the Government the penalty shall be 20% of the penalty proposed as above.

This project is one public utility project, hence the penal NPV is calculated as detailed below.

NPV per Ha.	= Rs. 6,26,000.00
Violation Forest Area	= 0.2584 Ha.
Period of violation	= 05.02.2020(date of inspection) to 02.11.2020 (date of Stage-I approval) = 272 days.
Penal NPV	= Rs.6,26,000 x 0.2584 Ha. x $\frac{272}{365}$ = Rs.1,20,543/- for 20 % = 24,109/-

In view of the above facts, it is requested to deposit / transfer the cost of NPV and cost of Penal NPV to State CAMPA Fund only through (<http://parivesh.nic.in>).

6. Penal NPV = Rs. 24,109/-


As per Condition No.xii in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order, the User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department. In this connection, the separate correspondence is being issued.

As per Condition No.xiii in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order, it is requested to please take immediate steps for obtaining FRA Certificate from the Collector, Dhenkanal immediately.

Further, it is to inform you that, since it is a liner project, the working permission in Forest Land will be issued for a period of **one year** pending Stage-II Forest Clearance on receipt of deposit particulars against cost of NPV, Penal NPV, Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan including Mangrove restoration.


Therefore, it is requested to please submit the deposit particulars / receipt along with compliance report of 26 conditions imposed in the **Stage-I in-principle** approval order and additional 05 conditions imposed vide Letter No. FF-DIV-FLD-0041-2020-10F(Cons)155/2020-17699/F&E dt.11.11.2020 of the Government of Odisha, Forest & Environment Department in 06 sets through booklet to this office immediately for further action at this end.




