In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's Letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.033 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited for erection of OFC in the existing road section which diverts from Madurai-Natham main road to Saranthangi village through Kiluvamalai R.F. in Alanganallur Block in Madurai District.

It is further certified that:

- (i) there are no Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers in Kiluvamalai R.F. of Madurai District and consequently no claims have been received under this Act with respect to the area proposed for erection of OFC in the existing road section.
- (ii) there are no Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre-Agricultural Communities (PAC) in the Kiluvamalai RF, Madurai District. So, the recognized rights of PTG and PAC are not affected.
