<i>Total Area required (including future development)</i>	= 36 Acre
<i>Total investment (excluding future development)</i>	= 65.5 Crore
<i>Total direct employment generation (apprx)</i>	= 400 Persons
<i>Total Employment (Direct + Indirect) (apprx)</i>	= 1600 Persons

While analyzing the benefit received from this kind of project we must keep one thing in our mind that the financial benefit is not the primary aim for government invested project but the main objective is to bring a social as well as financial benefit to the local people. We shall look into the various kind or benefits achieved from the development proposed.

Social /Socio - Economic Benefit- As already mentioned this is the primary objective for government initiative and investment. As per detailed above total direct employment generation prediction from the proposed development is 400 persons. This means indirect employment generation is three times of the same i.e 1200 persons (This covers the employment generated for fooding, transportation, household work and others of the directly employed persons). So, total 1600 employments can be generated from this proposed development. For a small suburb like Tarapith 1600 nos of employment means a lot and it shall bring a noticeable change in the socio economic condition of the local peoples.

Environmental Benefit- We have already mentioned the requirement of a proper sewerage management system for entire Tarapith area. The proposed Sewerage Treatment Plant shall serve as the solution to the issue and therefore it shall reduce the environmental pollution in tarapith area to a great extent.

Financial Benefit- We have already mentioned that financial profit is not the main motto behind investment in government projects. Still mainly due to enormous nos of tourist footfall at Tarapith almost all the development components shall turnout to be financially profitable one.
