In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (Moef), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under The Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is to certify that 4.97 Hectares of forest land out of Gat No. 223 proposed to be diverted in favour of Shri Jugai Minerals, Ghungur for Laterite Mining purpose in Kolhapur district is falling within the jurisdiction of Parali village in Shahuwadi Tehsil.

- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it;
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per Section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.

Extract of Resolution No.37 dated 16-09-2016 of Gram Sabha of Mouje Parali

Subject No.2 : Regarding the demand of Shri Jugai Minerals Ghungur, for Latterite Mining for H.4.97 from Gat No.223, area 262.46 H. of village Mouje Parali, Tal. Shahuwadi, Dist. Kolhapur.

Resolution No.37 : Shri Jugai Minerals Ghungur has demanded from Government to grant a land measuring H.4.97 from Gat No.223, area 262.46 H. of village Mouje Parali Tal. Shahuwadi, Dist. Kolhapur for Latterite Mining. Vide subject stated above, no objection of Village Panchayat and approval of Gram Sabha is expected. Herebefore, vide Gram Sabha Resolution No.71, dated 13-02-2016 No Objection Certificate and Resolution of Gram Sabha has already been issued. Eventhough, this Sabha has discussed in detail regarding abovesaid area getting due information in detail. The said area belongs to Forest Department and there are no Forests Rights Claims and other forest rights demands from anybody else. Accordingly, this Sabha is approving the demand according to the provisions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, Rules 2008 and Revised Rules 2012 as under:-.

1. The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under Forest Rights Act has been carried out for 4.97 Hectatres from Gat No.223, the forest land. There are no forest rights or claims on the proposed forest land.
2. The proposal for such diversion with full details of the project and it's implications, in Marathi language have placed before the Gram Sabha.
3. The proposed forest land will be used for latterite mining purpose, to which the Gram Sabha has given approval to it with due understanding taking into aaccount the provisions in the Forest Rights Act.
4. This Gram Sabha has a quoram of more than 50% of the adult members of the Gram Sabha of the village.
5. The Gram Sabha has approved the purpose of the project.
6. The proposed land is not required for the public purposes as mentioned in Section 3(2) of FRA, in near future.
7. There are no Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities in the village and no claims on the proposed land or on the forest lands as per section 3(1).

Accordingly, this Gram Sabha is approving the demand of the proposed land for latterite mining and the Gram Sabha has no any objection to grant the proposed forest land for latterite mining. Resolution passed in toto.
