NOTES

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, Δ represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the geoid-levelled bench-marks and not be strictly in accordance with them, but the discrepancy is unlikely to exceed 2 metres.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to October.
A relative height, Δ , against a well, in blue, indicates its total depth in metres.
In sand areas, cultivation is periodic and dependent on rainfall.


