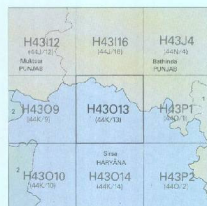

NOTES

A rearing height, h_r , marks along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal measured above the adjacent ground.

A rearing height, h_r , approximates the approximate height, in meters, between the top and bottom of a canal bank.

Tanks usually dry, in both arid and coastal regions, before or after the December.

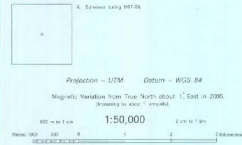
Suburbs are dense as throughout the canal, only the important ones near first stages.

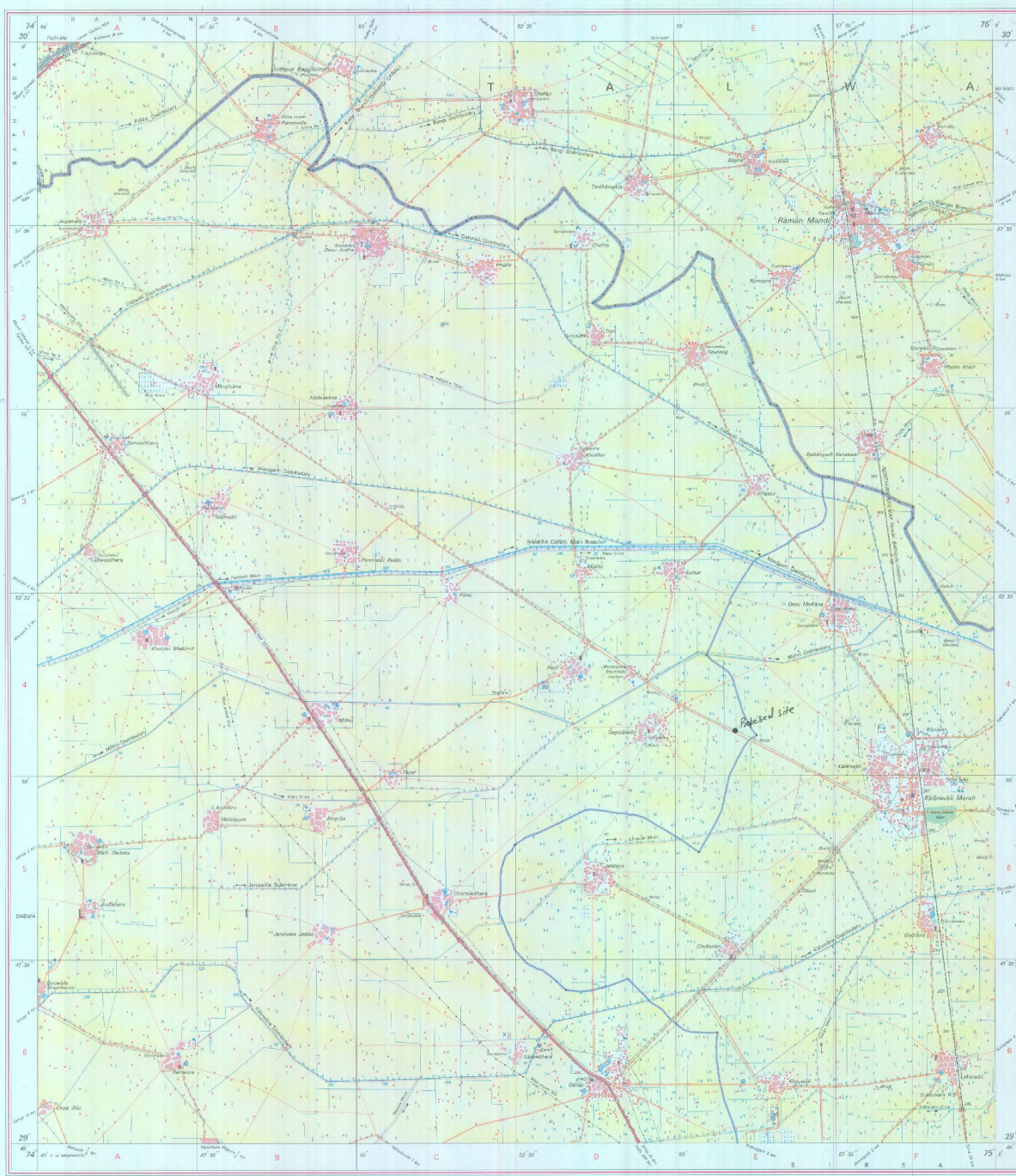


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
