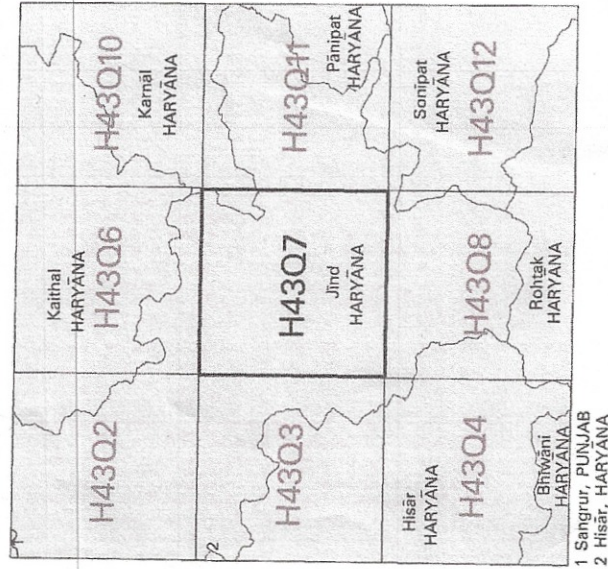


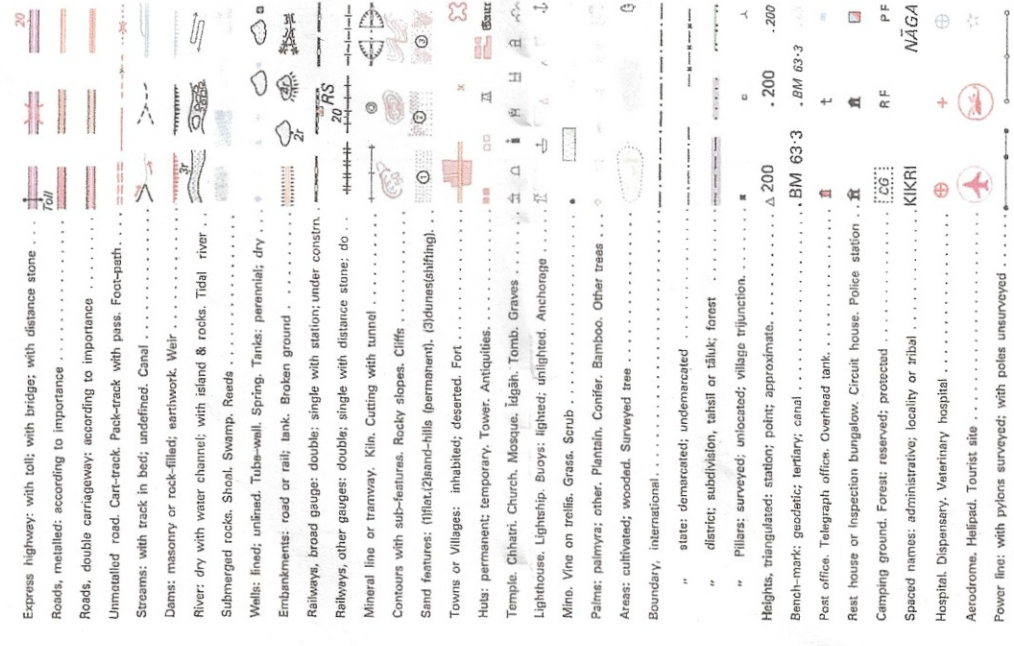

Trails shown in red, in this area usually contain water from July to March.

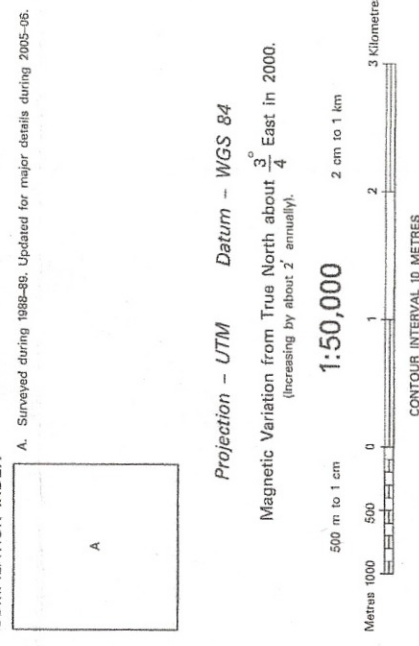
Shaded areas are swamps, and are usually encountered in dry seasons. Permission to use these areas is required from the Indian authorities.

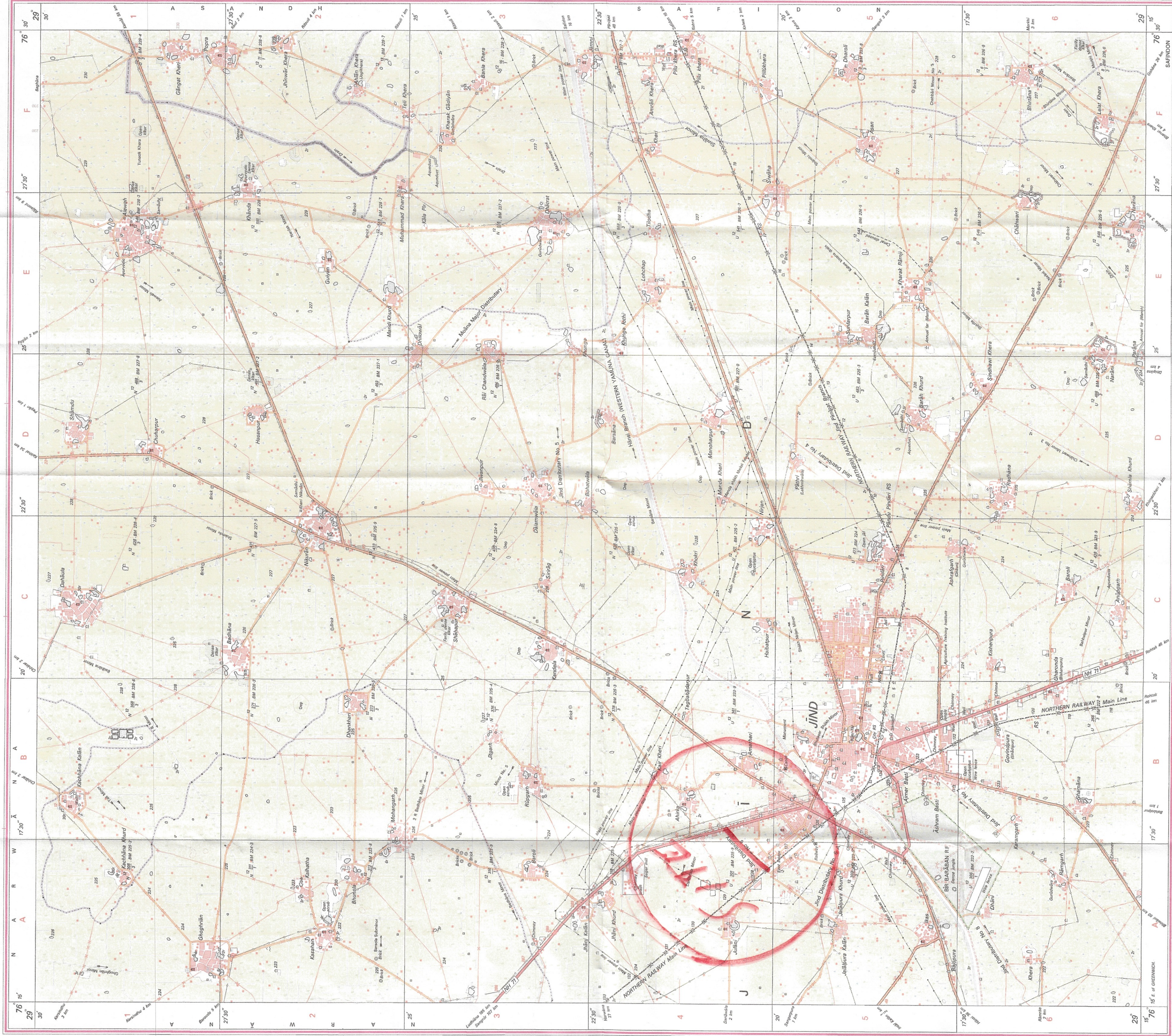
