## NOTES

Height are in metres from datum taken from road and railway levels. The top and bottom of a contour slope, if necessary, the maximum height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a contour slope.

Unlabelled roads and tracks in the areas are generally unmetalled or of a poor quality.

Railway lines in the map mostly connect cities from one to another.

The absolute errors between along the railway and roads are about 10 m. In high relief, where the distances between points are small, the errors may be larger.

Relative errors between along the railway and roads are about 10 m.

The errors between along the railway and roads are not been reduced by the height of the specific ground surface and may not be entirely in accordance with them.

The position accuracy between railway and roads is not been tested for want of other information.
