

Project Title- Manikpur to Sahebganj section of State Highway 74 (New NH 139W).

The project road starts from design chainage Km 0+000 (SH-74 at Manikpur village in Muzaffarpur District) to Km 42+800 (SH-74 at Bijdhari Mafi village of Purbi Champaran District) on New NH 139W under BRT Scheme.

Justification for Location of the Project in Forest Land

I/We, National Highway Authority of India, PIU-Motihari are proposing Four lane with paved shoulder of Manikpur to Sahebganj section of NH 139W design chainage km 0+000 to km 42+800 under BRT Scheme in districts of Muzaffarpur & Purbi Champaran in the state of Bihar on EPC mode.

The total length of the proposed alignment is 42.800 km.

The project road starts from new NH 139W (old SH 74) in Manikpur village of Muzaffarpur District with endpoint merging into NH 139W (old SH 74) in Bijdhari Mafi village of Purbi Champaran District in the state of Bihar. Proposed road is passing through existing alignment to develop into four lane with paved shoulder.

The proposed road is an essential highway up-gradation project and involved in conservation of existing intermediate lane to four lanes with paved shoulder as per NH standard. At some built-up area, realignment/bypass has been proposed to avoid the disturbance to inhabitants and acquisition of large number of structures. Efforts have been made to minimize the tree cutting of forest department to its minimum.

As per Notification of Annexure II Published by Government of Bihar, Forest & Environment Department dated 16.02.1994 Trees & Plantations nearby existing road, Canal Portions & Bypass areas has been declared as Notified Forest. Therefore, we understand that NOC is required from the Forest Department as per the Forest (Conservation) Act - 1980 [Chapter 11, Para. 11.1 (i) and Para. 11.6].
