NOTIFICATION

S.O. 3554  
WHEREAS it appears to the Central Government that coal is likely to be obtained from the lands mentioned in the Schedule hereto annexed ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government hereby gives notice of its intention to prospect for coal therein ;

2. The plan of the area covered by this notification can be inspected at the Office of the Central Coalfields Limited, (Revenue Section), Darbhanga House, Ranchi, or at the Office of the Collector, Mirzapur, (Uttar Pradesh), or at the Office of the Coal Controller, 1, Council House Street, Calcutta.

All persons interested in the land covered by this notification shall deliver all maps, charts and other documents referred to in sub-section (7) of section 13 of the said Act to the Revenue Officer, Central Coalfields Limited, Darbhanga House, Ranchi, within 90 days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

- D-D/1-E lines pass through Panth Sagar.
- E-F line passes along the southern and eastern boundary of village Rehata (which forms part common boundary of Panth Sagar).
- F-G line passes along the common boundary of villages Rehata and Garbandha.
- G-H-A lines pass through villages Parasi and Kakari and meets at starting point 'A'.

- K-L line passes along the part common boundary of villages Chilkadanr & Kota and along common boundary of villages Kharia & Kota.
- L-M line passes along the common boundary of villages Kharia, & Paraswar Chaube.
- M-N line passes along the common boundary of villages Paraswar Raja & Paraswar Babu.
- N-O line passes along the village boundary of villages Paraswar Raja, Marrak, Jogichoura, Bhairwa, Mishra, Koharoul & Koharoulia (which forms common boundary of Panth Sagar area).
- O-P-Q-R-S lines pass along the part common boundary of villages Koharoulia and Dhasari, then through villages Koharoulia Koharoul, Mishra, & Bhairwa (which forms common boundary of the area's acquired for Bina Block u/s 9(1) of the Coal Act).



S-I line passes along the part common boundary of villages Jamsila and Bhairwa (which forms part common boundary of the area acquired u/s 9(1) of the Coal Act for Pina Block) and meets at starting point 'I'.
