

 Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
 Cultivation is periodic and dependent on rainfall.
 The kilometre stone numbers along roads and canals are shown in slant type e.g., 5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g., 3'.
 Ferries on the Ken River only take pedestrian traffic.
