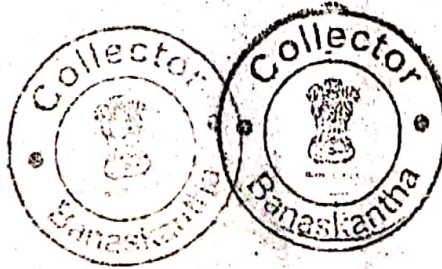

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act: 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 42.46625 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, Road and Building, Palanpur for the project of Four laning of Mitha Tharad Deesa Road(Section Deesa- Lakhni Road) Ch. 56/340 to 88/390 Tal.Deesa & Lakhni in Banaskantha District.
