Sub: Request for issuance of FRA Certificate under (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 in Form-1 for linear project for Diversion proposal of 4.338 Hectare of Reserve Forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 for construction of 7.005 kms of 33 kV D/C Transmission line from the Proposed 220/33 KV Pooling Substation at Kakkuppi village to the Proposed Windfarm in Sy No. 286, 368, 283, 282, 280, 301, 302, 304 306, and 314 of Kakkuppi village in Kudligi Taluk, and Sy No. 229 of Agrahara village kudligi Taluk in Bellary Forest Division of Karnataka State in favor of Renew Green Energy Solutions Private Limited.

Respected Sir,

We take this opportunity to introduce ourselves as “RENEW GREEN ENERGY SOLUTIONS PRIVATE LIMITED” we are actively engaged in development of Solar Power Projects in India, we are planning to project development of 33 kV D/C Transmission line from the Proposed 220/33 KV Pooling Substation at Kakkuppi village to the Proposed Windfarm in Kudligi Taluk of Bellary Forest Division of Karnataka State. The project shall from part of State Grid and would become a vital link for bulk power transfer of around 50 MW to Karnataka State

As per the route survey the line is passing through Kakkuppi, Suravanahalli and Agrahara Villages of Kudligi taluk of Vijayanagara district in Karnataka State. We have tried our outmost to avoid the use of forest land but could not eliminate it completely. The above proposed Transmission line is passing through forest division of Bellary for which route alignment has been drawn on cadastral /Village map as well as on Survey of India Toposheet of 1:50000 scales for necessary processing for approval of forest cases comes under your territorial limit.

It is mentioned here that 4.338 hectare of reserve forest land is falling under the following villages of Bellary Forest Division in Karnataka State.

We have already applied the forest diversion case & filled the Form A Part- I on MoEF&CC, Parivesh portal and the unique proposal no. is FP/KA/TRANS/154485/2022 and proposal has been examined by Nodal officer Forest (Conservation) Act-1980, Government of Karnataka and has been found to be complete in all respects. As per the process and guidance from Nodal office we have submitted six copies of proposal file in DCF office and now submitting the proposal file in (One) copy containing the prescribed form and documents as per the rules of MoEF&CC, Forest Department Govt. of India. In your good office for issuance of FRA certificate as per the provision of Schedule Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest rights) Act. 2006, and FRA guideline No - 11-43/2013-FC, Dated: 26th February 2019.

We requesting your good office to process for settlement of rights in respect of land proposed for diversion for non- forest purpose need to be completed for further processing of case under FCA,1980. It is requested you that necessary certificate regarding the settlement of rights under FRA, 2006 in respect of 4.338 ha. of reserve forest land proposed for diversion in above villages may please be issue for onward submission to MoEF&CC for enabling us in timely completion of National Interest Intra-State transmission line project in Karnataka State. We look forward for your kind support in this matter.

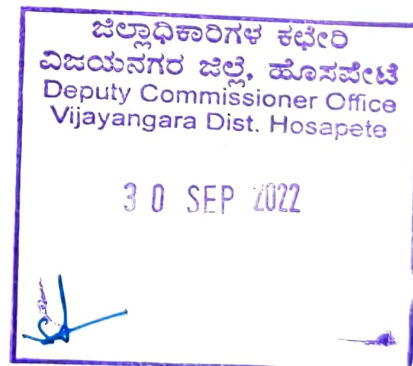

**Sub: Compliance of the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers
(Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006-regarding**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Forest (Conservation) amendment Rules 2016 as amended on 06th March, 2017 wherein inter-alia it has been provided that:

- (e) *the District Collector shall*
- (i) *complete the process of recognition and vesting of forest rights in accordance with the provisions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (2 of 2007) for the entire forest land indicated in the proposal.*
 - (ii) *obtain consent of each Gram Sabha having jurisdiction over the whole or a part of the forest land indicated in the proposal for the diversion of such forest land and compensatory and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purposes and details of diversion, wherever required; and*
 - (iii) *forward his findings in this regard to the Conservator of Forests*
- (f) *the entire process referred to in clause (e) shall be completed by the District Collector within the time period stipulated in these rules for grant of in-principle approval under the Act to the proposal.*
- (g) *the Conservator of Forests shall examine the factual details and feasibility of the proposal, carry out site inspection in case the area of forest land proposed to be diverted is more than forty hectares, and forward the proposal along with his recommendations to the Nodal Office.*

I am also directed to refer to references/communications received from various State Governments seeking clarification on whether FRA certificate is to be submitted before Stage-II compliance or it has been submitted along-with proposal for seeking Stage-I approval.

It is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of stage-I

condition, Deputy Commissioner shall complete the process of compliance of FRA (including forwarding its findings to the concerned CF). Hence for the purpose of the MoEF&CC, as per the provision under Forest (Conservation) amendment rules, 2016 the compliance under FRA is not required for consideration of in-principle approval. This has to be furnished by the state Govt. for consideration of the proposal by the ministry for final approval.

In view of the above, the State Governments are requested to adhere the provisions contained in Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules, 2016 for FRA purpose while forwarding the proposal for seeking prior approval under Section 2 of Forest(Conservation) Act,1980 to this Ministry for consideration.
