


Description of the Project

Anandpur Sahib is a sub-division in Ropar District. It is a town where Asia's most visited museum Virast-e-Khalsa is situated and every year lacs of domestic and foreign tourists visit this place during hola Mohalla. The place is also headquarter of one of the five Takhats of Sikh religion. Mata Naina Devi temple where thousands of people pay their obeisance is also located nearby.

The project for construction of pathway at the embankment road along Sri Naina Devi road near SDM office and civil hospital in Anandpur Sahib is aimed at providing facility to the tourists visitor and the local inhabitants. In this project, following interventions have been planned at an estimated cost of Rs. 4 crores.
