

**To whomsoever it may concern**

The entire NPCL Project situated near to the sea coast. Regarding, Rehabilitation & Resettlement for the project affected areas the Fisher men community have requested to allot the land near to the sea coast for eking out their lively hood.

Accordingly, a joint inspection team has been constituted in this case along with these Officers i.e., Special Deputy Collector, Kovvada, Revenue Divisional Officer Srikakulam, Divisional Forest Officer, Srikakulam, Asst. Director of Survey & Land Records Srikakulam, Tahsildar Etcherla for identification of suitable land along with project level committee and the PDFs. Initially an extent of Ac.177 cents covered in Sy.No.121 of Mentada and Sy.No.62 of NGR Puram of Ranasthlam (M) has been identified. But, as per records and CRZ survey most of the land is covered in the CRZ Zone III area leaving very little extent for construction of R and R Colony. In addition to the inadequate extent, the project affected people have not shown interest to shift towards south under their beliefs. Hence, this option of locating R and R colony is not exercised. Another site was selected and proposed to project affected people at Sy.No.2 covered with an approximate extent of Ac.900.00 cents of Konadamulagam of Ranasthlam (M). But, the project affected people did not prefer the site as the site is far away from the coast and they cannot continue their profession.

Finally, the land covered in Sy.No. 551 to an extent of Ac.88.00 and in Sy.No. 553 to an extent of Ac,125.82 totally to an extent of Ac.213.82 belongs to Forest Dept., of Dharmavaram (V) of Etcherla Mandal has been identified for setting up R&R Colony for the PDFs of Kovada Nuclear Power Project. All the 6 project affected villages have unanimously agreed to settle at Dharmavaram (V) of Etcherla (M) R & R facilities are provided as per provisions of NEW LARR Act. And, the land measuring to an extent of Ac.238.52 cents in Sy.No.29-3 classified as Konda(Hill) Poramboke of Tamada (V), Laveru (M), belongs to Revenue Department has been identified in lieu of forest land to be handed over under compensatory afforestation to the Forest Department.

It is submitted that in pursuance of the minutes and instructions issued in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, my self along with Assistant Director, Survey & Land Records, Srikakulam, Divisional Forest Officer, Srikakulam, Special Deputy Collector, Kovvada, Senior Executive Engineer, NPCIL, Kovvada Nuclear Power Project, Tahsildars, Etcherla and Laveru have inspected the proposed lands for R & R Colony for PDFs of Kovvada Nuclear Power Park in Sy. No. 551, 553 in Dharmavaram Village in Etcherla Mandal on 08.02.2017 and I submit the report as follows.,

It is further submitted that the lands in Sy. No. 551 an extent of Ac. 88.00 and in Sy. No. 553 an extent of Ac.125.82 cents, totally Ac 213.82 cents were handed over to the Forest Department vide Rc. No. 311/99-A Dt. 04.01.2000 of Tahsildar, Etcherla duly conducting joint inspection by the Revenue & Forest officials. It is also submitted that an extent of Ac 24.70 cents in Sy.No:55P in Ramachandrapuram Revenue Village of Ranasthalam Mandal is covered in NPP, Kovvada area was also handed over to Forest Department as compensatory a forestation instead of the lands taken over from Forest Department for Singarenicolories Ltd., Kottagudem. At present, this extent of Ac 24.70 cents is fallen in between the proposed cite of NPP Kovvada thus the total extent of Ac238.52cents which belongs to Forest Department now needed for Kovvada Nuclear Park and there is need to allot an alternative land for the purpose of aforestation and to be handed to the Forest Department.

Further, It is submitted that in response to the instructions issued of the District Collector, Srikakulam in the reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited myself along with the Assistant Director, Survey & Land Records, Srikakulam, Divisional Forest Officer, Srikakulam, Special Deputy Collector, Kovvada, Senior Executive Engineer, NPCIL, Kovvada Nuclear Power Project, Tahsildars, Etcherla and Laveru were inspected the following lands in Tamada Village of Laveru Mandal on 06.05.2017.


It is submitted that as per Survey Land Records, Survey No.29 an extent of Ac.700.45cents classified as "Hill Poramboke". From the inception of the Mandal the then Tahsildar have issued D-Pattas


to Weaker section for an extent of Ac.456.93cents. On physical verification on ground they are cultivating the lands by way of Eucalyptus and cashew since from the date of sanction.


It is further submitted that as per the instructions of the District Collector, Srikakulam constituted a technical team consisting of 4 surveyors, 2 Village Revenue Officers are surveyed the entire "Hill Poramboke" under the supervision of Inspector of Survey through GPS System. According to the co-ordinates which were recorded in the GPS the extent is tallied. There is no variation between the Record and Ground. After deducting the D-Pattas an extent of Ac238.52cents (Ac700.45-Ac456.93) is available. The land is suitable for cultivating the Eucalyptus and Cashew etc and connected to which leads to National High 16 which is at a distance of 6kms from the proposed land.

In this connection it is submitted that keeping in view of Kovvada Nucleare Power Project in Ranasthalam Mandal the District Administration has proposed to rehabilitate the entire village in the available land which was belongs to Forest Department at Dharmavaram Village of Etcherla Mandal.


In view of the above the Joint inspection team therefore request that the land to an extent of **Ac.238.52cents in Sy.No.29** in Tamada Village may kindly be transferred to the Forest Department as a substitute to Dharmavaram lands (Ac213.82cents) and the Forest lands covered in Ramachandrapuram Revenue Village of Ranasthalam Mandal(Ac24.70cents)which comes to a total extent of Ac238.52cents.. The sketch showing the details of the alternative land proposed for Forest Department in Tamada Village of Laveru Mandal is submitted herewith.




