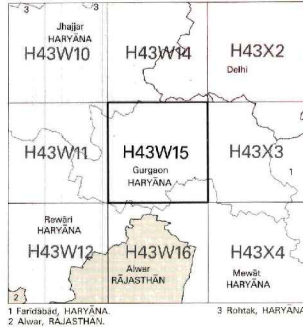

NOTES

- A water height of 1.5 m marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country
- Tide gauge, dry, in the area usually covered water from July to March
- A water height of 1.5 m, represents the approximate height of water between the top and bottom of a ship's hull
- Unmetalled roads and cart tracks in this area are generally not suitable for use in dry season. Permission to use cart tracks along roads or required from the Impression authorities
