In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) Dated: 03.08.2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that **4.41 hectares** of forest Land in Chaganam Reserve Forest, Chaganam Village of Sydapuram Mandal proposed to be diverted in favour of M/s. Chettinad Morimura Semiconductor Material Pvt.Ltd (name of user agency) for mining lease in Chaganam Village, Sydapuram Mandal, in SPSR Nellore District falls within jurisdiction of RF in Chaganam Village of Sydapuram Mandal of Gudur Division. It is further certified that:

- The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **4.41 Hectares** of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure A & B.
- The proposal for such diversion(with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest -dwellers, who eligible under the FRA;
- The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities /processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Chaganam Rajupalem Village(s) is enclosed as annexure A & B.
- The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- The right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguard as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.
