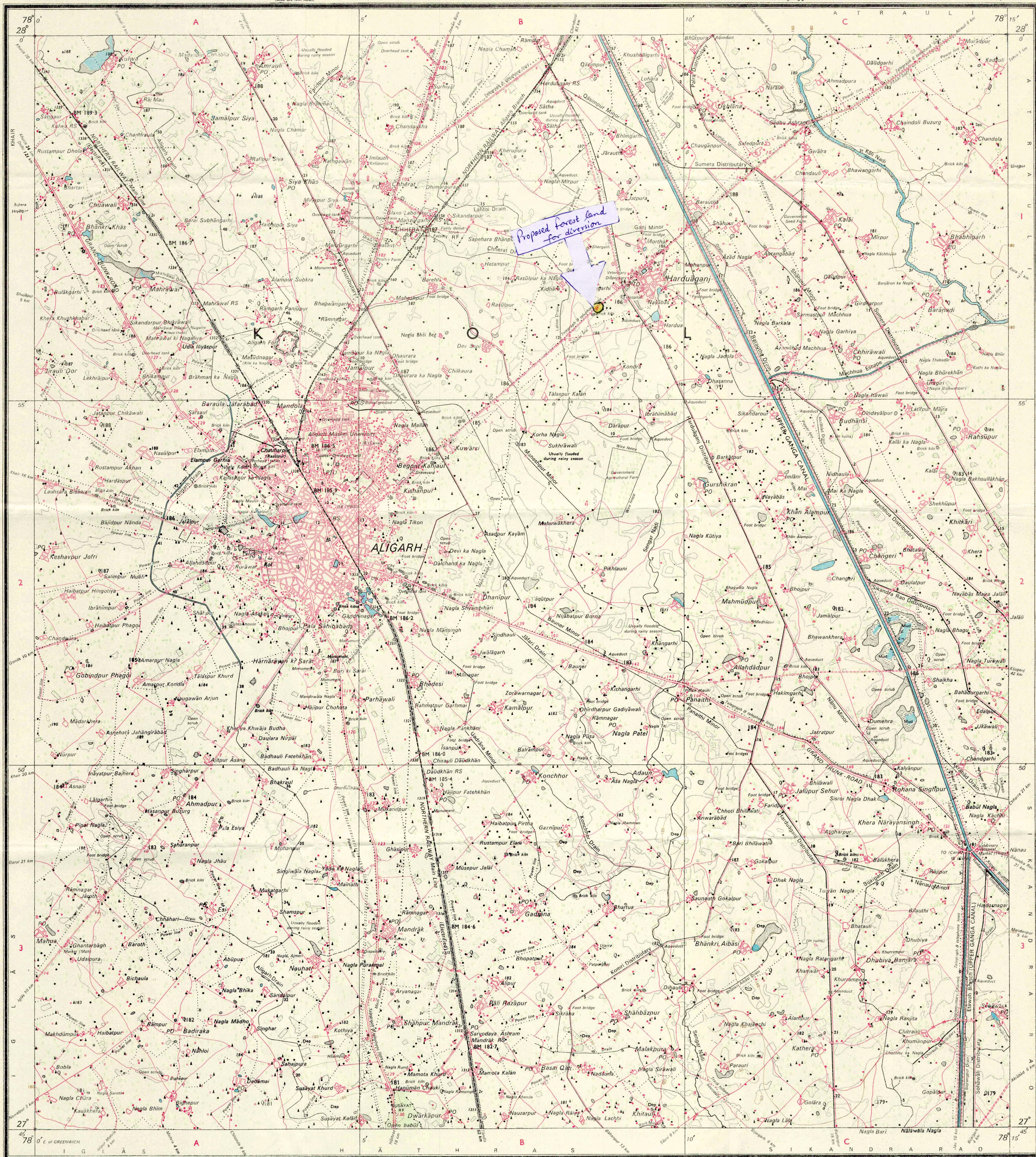
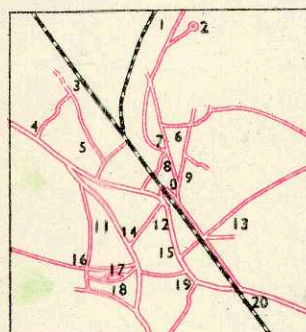

All cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
A relative height, e.g., 45, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country. The traverse heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled benchmarks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads and railways are shown in slant type, e.g., '15' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '52'.
Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
Some roads and cart-tracks in this sheet, have been incorporated as a result of verification survey carried out during 1975-76. This sheet has been compiled from 1:25,000 survey.
