Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad reference 3rd cited above has issued instructions that, the charges for felling, logging, transportation of project affected tress and the funds towards expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc., should be deposited with the Divisional Forest Officers (now DFOs/FDOs) concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in order to ensure that the task of felling / transportation / stone pillars etc., The details are as follows.

Further, the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Karimnagar is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the instructions issued by the GoI, MoEF&CC, New Delhi vide F.No.7-23-2012-FC, dated 24.07.2013.

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the central government in two widely circulated daily news paper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

The transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval (or) working permission whichever is earlier.
