It is to inform that, vide ref 5th cited, the Government has approved (Stage-I) for diversion of 4.023 Ha of Forest Land in Tallada Range of Khammam Division for laying of Pipe line and Construction of other structures in Segment -26/1 of(Wyra) Under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of SE, I TDWSP(RWS & S) Circle, Khammam passing through Reserve Forest areas of Khammam forest division in Khammam District in favour of the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP(RWS & S) Circle., Khammam duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied and communicated by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 6th cited.

In view of the above, it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV and other charges as shown below:

The User Agency has to deposit the above payment through e-portal method only by generating challan at Ministry's web portal i.e., forestsclerance.nic.in. To generate the challan, the UA has to enter the details of demand notice raised in Ministry's web portal, which has to be vetted by the Nodal Officer, FCA, Telangana State. Then only the challan has to be generated for depositing into any one of the Telangana Compensatory Afforestation Funds (CAF)/Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPAs) specific CAMPAs Saving bank Accounts maintained in either of the Banks mentioned below:

- 1) Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road New Delhi-110003 (RTGS/IFSC No. CORP0000371) SB A/c. No. 037100101029963.
- 2) Union Bank of India, Sundar Nagar, New Delhi-110003 (RTGS/IFSC No.UBIN0534498) SB A/c. No. 344902010106351.

Once the challan is generated the User Agency has to transfer the funds into the Ad-hoc CAMPA accounts through RTGS and furnish a copy of UTR number. Further the charges for Tree growth (Timber) Extraction and Transportation mentioned in the Sl.No. 6 for an amount of Rs.0.54062 Lakh has to be deposited in DDO Account No. 52202890509, Treasury Branch SBH, Khammam for extraction of trees.

Further, User Agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the Govt instructions issued vide F. No. 7-23/2012-FC, dt 24.07.2013 communicated vide P.C.C.F, A.P, Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dated: 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent.

- 1) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.
- 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further the Superintending Engineer, TDWSP(RWS & S) Circle., Khammam is also informed that, the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the expert committee shall be charged by the State Government from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect. All the following conditions shall be complied and requested to furnish the compliance report on the following:

- (i) The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters @ cost of user agency.
- (iii) Maximum number of trees to be felled shall not be more than fifty trees per hectare.
- (iv) The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, dated : 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the orders issued by State Government vide G.O.Ms.No.124 EFS&T (For.I) Dept., dt: 27.07.2010.
- (v) Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be paid by the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- (vi) The additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be paid by the User Agency and deposited either in SB A/c. No.037100101029963 of Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003 (RTGS/IFSC No.CORP0000371) or in SB A/c. No.344902010106351 of Union Bank of India, Sundar Nagar, New Delhi-110003.

- (vii) The proposal shall be examined under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 as per the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment & Forests vide letter No.11-9/1998 - FC(Pt) dated: 05.07.2013, and requisite certificates / documents be furnished.
- (viii) Other condition specified in the GOI, MoEF, letters dated: 03.01.2005, 13.05.2011, 16.06.2011, 13.02.2014 and 07.11.2014 shall also be complied with by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad and User Agency with which they are concerned.
- (ix) The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 4.023 Ha. In case the land is not taken over by the User Agency or the same is not used for the stipulated purpose within a period of two years, then the area shall be taken back by the Forest Department.
- (x) The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to the flora/fauna in the surroundings.
- (xi) Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the Forest Department.
- (xii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- (xiii) Forest land to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Government.
- (xiv) The Forest Department may impose from time to time any other condition(s) in the interest of conservation, protection and / or development of forests;
- (xv) Transfer of forest land to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this approval shall automatically stand revoked.

After receipt of the compliance report on the above mentioned conditions the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to the user agency shall not be effected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principal approval valid for a period of (5) years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principal approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
