

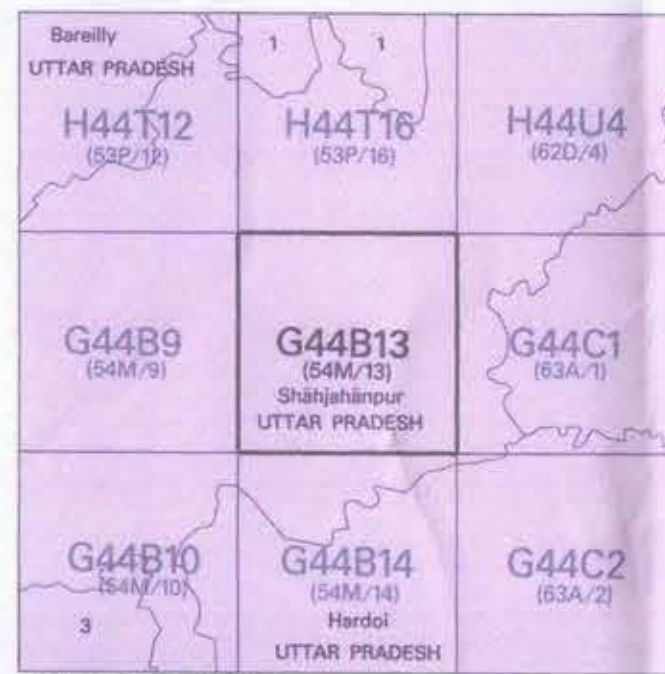

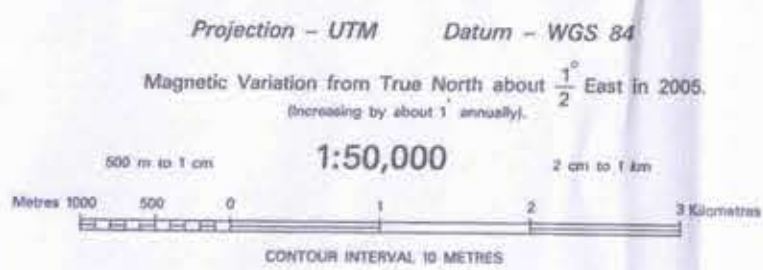

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December.

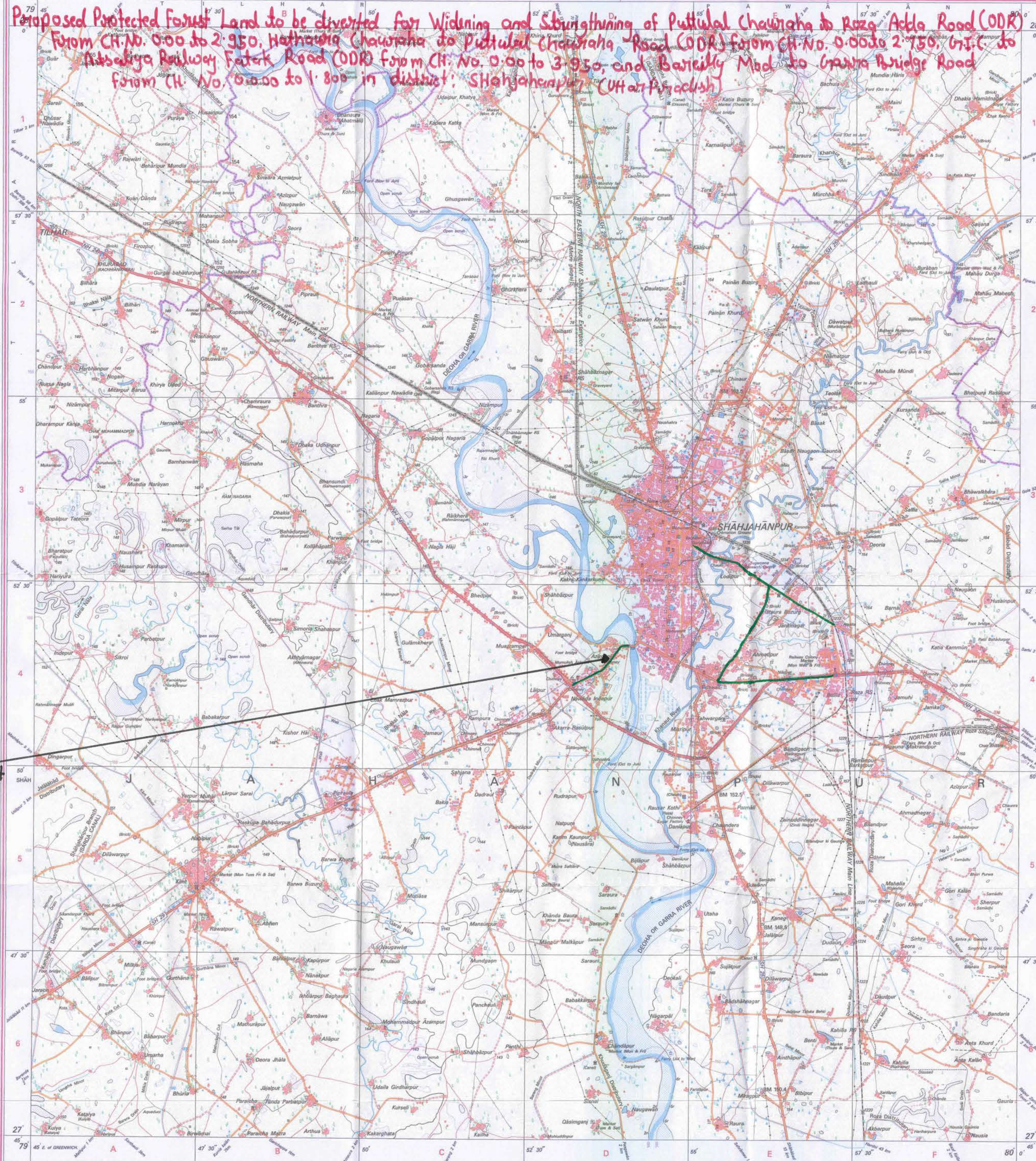
