A relative height, e.g., 50, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.

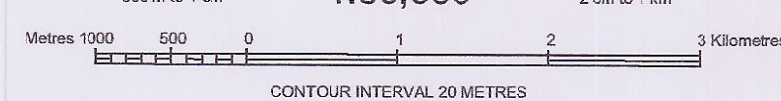

CONTOUR INTERVAL 20 METRES

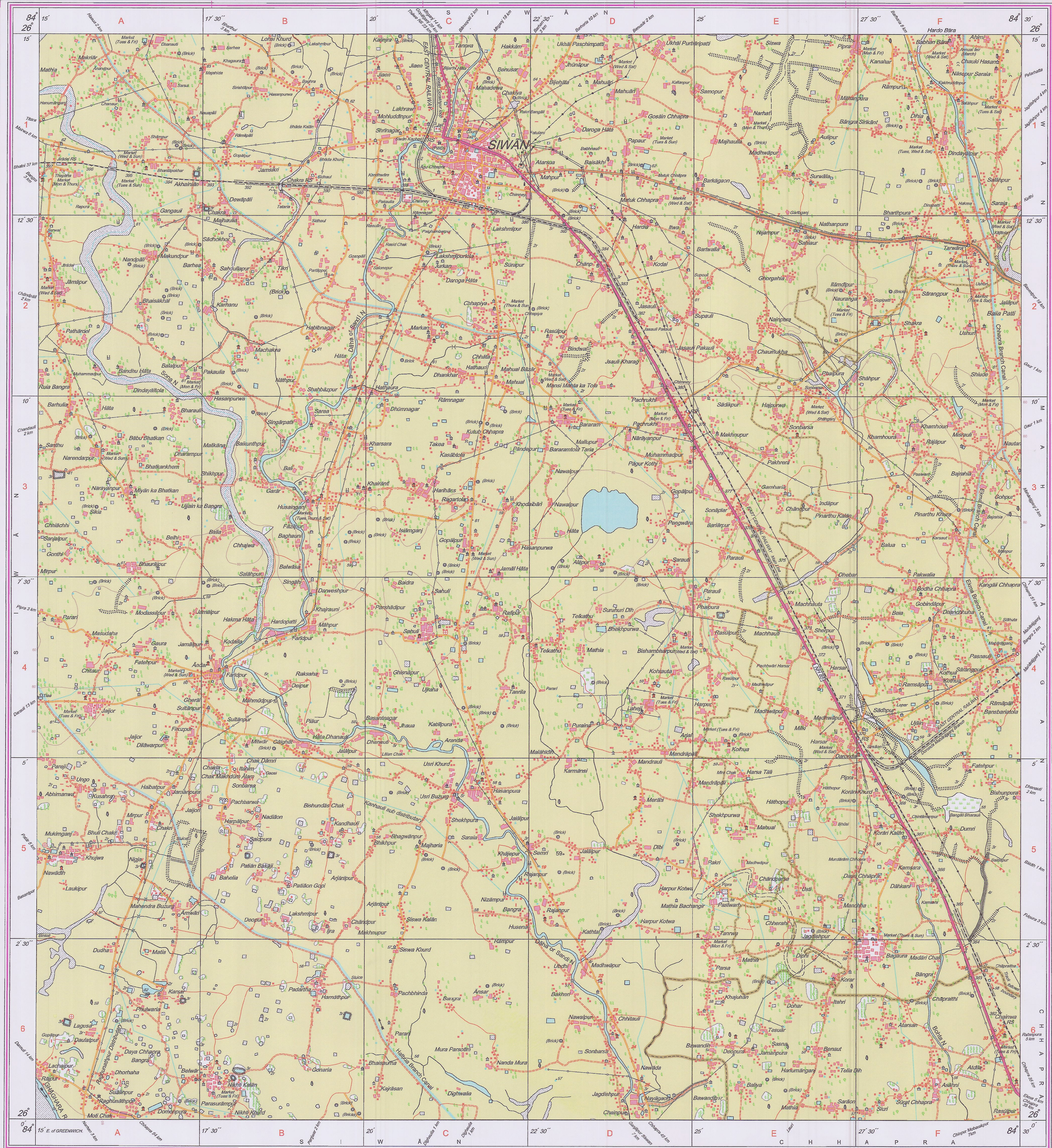
