It is submitted that the Government of India vide reference 7th cited has conveyed Central Government **in-principle (Stage.I) approval** under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of **2.351 ha** in Kamareddy forest division under Kamareddy District, for laying of Pipe Line and construction of structures in **Segment-12/5 (Lingampet)** - for providing safe drinking water to erstwhile **Nizamabad District and presently Kamareddy District** - under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project, in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report in the matter, vide reference 8th cited.

Accordingly, the District Forest Officer, Kamareddy has obtain compliance of conditions from the User Agency/Forest Divisional Officer, Kamareddy; and submitted the condition-wise compliance report together with its enclosures through I/c Chief Conservator of Forests, Nizamabad, which is received in this office through reference 10th cited. A copy of reference 10th cited together with its enclosures **in triplicate** are enclosed herewith.

The condition-wise compliance report is reproduced with remarks as follows:-
