Subject: Diversion of 0.54 ha of forest land in Villupuram Forest Division for laying of underground OFC to a length of 17.99 km along Vadakkananthal to Thumbal road section in Parigam RF in Kallakuruchi District in favour of M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited, Chennai-Reg.

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government letter No.8774/FR.10/2022-1 dated 20.06.2022 and online proposal No. FP/TN/Others/38130/2019 seeking prior approval of the Government of India in accordance with Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above mentioned project. The project was accorded in-principle approval (Stage-I) by the Central Government vide letter dated 12.07.2022. The State Government vide letter No.8774/FR-10/2022-2 dated 12.12.2022, have reported compliance to the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval;

After careful consideration of the compliance report submitted by the State Government and importance of the project, I am directed to convey the Central Government's **final approval (Stage-II)** under Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of **0.54 ha** of forest land in Villupuram Forest Division for laying of underground OFC to a length of 17.99 km along Vadakkananthal to Thumbal road section in Parigam RF in Kallakuruchi District in favour of M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited, Chennai, **for a period of 25 years**, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;
- (ii) Concrete pillars claimed to be erected for demarcation shall be maintained at the cost of the User Agency;
- (iii) The State Government shall carryout Compensatory Afforestation and its maintenance for a period of 10 years over an extent of **1.08 ha** of degraded forest land identified in the Parigam RF, from the amount which was already realized from the User Agency;

- (iv) Full exemption of NPV is allowed in case of laying of underground OFC cable provided no felling of trees is involved and area proposed for diversion is outside of Protected Area as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines. But in case an amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency;
- (v) **The maximum size of the trench shall not exceed 2.00 mtr depth, 17.99 Km length and 0.30mtrwidth. The forest land shall be restored to its original state after laying the same;**
- (vi) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
- (vii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (viii) Disturbance shall be kept minimal by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the machinery, labourers & staff engaged in execution of work shall not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna;
- (ix) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- (x) **No tree felling shall be carried out by the User Agency;**
- (xi) The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government;
- (xii) The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed **0.54 ha** and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal;
- (xiii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- (xiv) User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project;
- (xv) Any other conditions that the Central Government or Regional officer(Central) of the Integrated Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and

management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the User Agency;

- (xvi) In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as per the provisions in Ministry's guidelines.
