Sub: Diversion of 10.58 ha of revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centers of Excellence namely Cardio- thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS.

Sir,

In inviting reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Eastern Regional Office, Bhubaneswar have accorded Stage-I approval vide their Letter F.No. 5-ORC439/2020- BHU dated 07.01.2021 for diversion of 10.58 ha of revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centers of Excellence namely Cardio- thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, subject to fulfilment of twenty eight (28) nos of conditions stipulated therein. The User Agency has complied all the conditions imposed by Govt. of India, MoEF & CC, ERO, Bhubaneswar. In this regard, the point wise compliance based on the report of the RCCF, Bhubaneswar Circle is furnished as under:-

PART - A

Condition No- (i) The User Agency shall transfer online the Net Present Value (NPV) of 10.58 hect. forest land being diverted under their proposal, as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5.3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has already deposited an amount of Rs. 66, 23, 080/- vide UTR No. BKIDH 21089667481 dated 30.03.2021 out of the total amount deposited Rs.1,06,60,980/- vide NEFT/RTGS challan dated 23.09.2021, which is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

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Condition No- (ii):- *The Identified non-forest land of 10.58 hecs. for raising compensatory Afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of the Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the identified Govt. non-forest revenue land over 10.5 ha. in Mouza: Badasereipur, Dorabada under Narendrapur GP of Banapur Tahasil of Khordha District for raising compensatory afforestation has been transferred & mutated in favour of the Forest & Environment Department, Government of Odisha which has been communicated to the Special Secretary to Government, Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department, Odisha vide their Letter No.15018 dt.08.10.2021 of the Collector & District Magistrate, Khordha district with copy of RoR, with a copy endorsed to Principal Chief Conservator Forests & HoFF, Odisha of the next Memo of even date, which is enclosed as **Annexure- II**. Proposal for PF notification of the mutated non-forest Govt. land identified for raising of CA over 10.58 ha at village Badasereipur Dorabada has been submitted to the Govt. vide this office Memo No.19871 dated 23.11.2021.

Condition No- (iii) *The land Identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India Topo Sheet: of 1:50,000 scale.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the Compensatory Afforestation land has been identified in Plot No.18,19 and 30 of Khata No.307 of Mouza Badasareipur, Dorabada under Narendrapur G.P. of Banapur Tahasil of Khordha District, the location of CA land has been clearly depicted in Survey of India Topo Sheet No.E45B1 of 1: 50,000 scale, which is enclosed as **Annexure-III**.

Condition No- (iv) *The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the Compensatory Afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned state through online portal .The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency had initially deposited the cost of raising Compensatory Afforestation to an amount of Rs.40,72,100/- at the wage rate of 308/- per MD, which is enclosed as Annexure-I & the balance amount of Rs. 34,200/- deposited vide RTGS challan dated 05.05.2021 which is enclosed as **Annexure-IV A**.

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However, due to enhancement of wage rate @ 311/-MD the total cost of CA has been raised to Rs. 40,94,400/-. So the differential amount of Rs.22,300/- has been deposited by the User Agency vide NEFT RTGS Challan dated 30.09.2021 vide UTR No.BKIDN21274230157 dated 01.10.2021 as demanded by the DFO, City Forest Division vide his office Memo No.5291 dated 14.09.2021, which is enclosed as **Annexure- IV B & IV C.**

Condition No- (v) All the funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred deposited in CAMPA Account only e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in>).

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has deposited all the amount related to this project i.e. cost of NPV & cost of CA in CAMPA Account by e-portal <https://parivesh.nic.in>, which has been downloaded and enclosed as **Annexure-V** & also payment statement in prescribed CAMPA format duly signed by the DFO, City Forest Division and under signed is enclosed as **Annexure-V A.**

Condition No- (vi) The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking to deposit the amount towards cost of felling of trees with the Forest Department as per their demand., which is enclosed as **Annexure-VI.**

Condition No- (vii) The compliance report of Stage -I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in>..

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they will upload their compliance report of Stage-I approval on e-portal <https://parivesh.nic.in>, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VII.**

Condition No- (viii) The complete compliance of the FRA 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has submitted the clearance certificate in Form No-II under Forest Right Act 2006 from the District Collector, Khordha district, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VIII.**

Condition No- (ix) The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high rain forced cement concrete pillars each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS Co-ordinates.

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Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the boundary of the proposed forest land has been demarcated on the ground by erecting four feet height RCC pillars each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS Co-ordinates.. The map of the proposed diversion area has been submitted in **Annexure-IX** also GPS co-ordinates of the boundary pillars posted around the forest land proposed to be diverted over 10.58 ha in favour of the AIIMS, Bhubaneswar having 21 nos. of pillars posted around with pillar to pillar distance duly authenticated by the DFO, City Forest Division which has been annexed herewith as **Annexure – IX A.**

Condition No- (x) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.55-2/2017 -FC dated 28.03.2019.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they will not violate the condition of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 which is enclosed as **Annexure-X.**

PART – B

Condition No- (i) Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that the legal status of Forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged, which is enclosed as **Annexure- I.**

Condition No- (ii) Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over 10.58 hect. of non-forest land identified in village Badasareipur- Darabad under BanpurTahasil under Khurdha Forest Division within three years from the date of Stage-II clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency and at least 1000 plants per hect. shall be planted over identified non-forest land within three years of grant of final approval. If it is not possible to plant so many sapling in the area identified for C.A, the balance sapling will be planted in any other forest as per prescription approved Working Plan with provision of 10 years subsequent maintenance .

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar has reported that the Compensatory afforestation @ 1600 plants per hect. with 10 years maintenance over an area of 10.58 hect. with approved financial outlay of Rs. 40,94,400/- at the wage rate of Rs.311/- per manday will be carried out in village Badasareipur- Darabada under Banpur Tahasil of Khordha district under Khordha Forest Division as per the approved scheme by the Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FD & Nodal) O/O the Pr. CCF, Odisha, Bhubaneswar. The copy of such the approved financial outlay is enclosed as **Annexure- II.**

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Condition No- (iii) At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an under taking to pay the additional of NPV, if so determined as per the final decision of the Hon' ble Supreme Court of India.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that the user agency shall pay the additional of NPV, if so determined as per the final decision of the Hon' ble Supreme Court of India, which is enclosed as **Annexure- III**

Condition No- (iv) The User Agency shall limit the construction of building over 6.28 hect. of forest land and increase for Greenery activities from 1.28 hect. to 2.28 hect. of forest land.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that all construction works of building will be limited over 6.28 ha of proposed forest land take initiative to increase Greenery activities from 1.28 hect. to 2.28 hect. of forest land, which is enclosed as **Annexure-IV**.

Condition No- (v) The User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental protection Act 1986 if applicable.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar has reported that the User Agency has submitted the environmental clearance received from the Under Secretary to Govt. of Odisha, Health & Family Welfare Department vide Memo. No. 19583 dt. 06.08.2009 which is enclosed as **Annexure-V**.

Condition No- (vi) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressures on the nearby forest area.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they will not allow establishment of any labour camp on the forest land and also undertake to provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and staff working at the site to avoid the damage to nearby forest areas, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VI**.

Condition No- (vii) No additional of new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the Project work.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that no additional of new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activities related to the project work, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VII**.

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Condition No- (viii) *The User Agency while executing, works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest areas in any manner.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they shall not fell any trees or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area during the execution of work, which is enclosed as **Annexure-VIII**.

Condition No- (ix) *The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they shall not change the layout plan of the proposed forest land without the prior approval of the Govt. of India, MoEF, which is enclosed as **Annexure-IX**.

Condition No- (x) *The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal, which is enclosed as **Annexure-X**.

Condition No- (xi) *The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstance to be transferred to any other User Agency, Department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that the proposed forest land for diversion will not be transferred to any other User Agency, Department or Persons under any circumstances without prior approval of the MoEF & CC which is enclosed as **Annexure-XI**.

Condition No- (xii) *No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining caused.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they will not cause any damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area, which is enclosed as **Annexure- XII**.

Condition No- (xiii) *The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that therein no adverse impact in the forest in the surrounding area.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the Divisional Forest Officer, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar has furnished an undertaking that he will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures for ensuring no adverse impact in the forest of the surrounding area, which is enclosed as **Annexure- XIII.**

Condition No- (xiv) *The User Agency shall explore the possibility of successful translocation of maximum numbers of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is on avoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that every care would be taken for successful translocation of maximum number of trees identified for felling and only unavoidable trees will be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department, which is enclosed as **Annexure-XIV.**

Condition No- (xv) *The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of User Agency or the project life, whichever is less.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that the period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of them or the project life, whichever is less which is enclosed as **Annexure- XV.**

Condition No- (xvi) *The User Agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated condition to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned intrigued Regional Office of the Ministry by the end of March every year.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they will submit the annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) O/O the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Odisha, Bhubaneswar and the IRO, Bhubaneswar through the Divisional Forest Officer, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar by the end of March every year which is enclosed as **Annexure-XVI.**

Condition No- (xvii) *Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of Afforestation, Conservation and Management of Flora and Fauna in the area, shall be complied by the User Agency.*

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the RCCF, Bhubaneswar reported that the User Agency has furnished an undertaking that they shall comply any other conditions imposed by the MoEF& CC from time to time in the interest of Afforestation, Conservation and Management of Flora and Fauna in the area, which is enclosed as **Annexure-XVII.**

Condition No- (xviii) *The State Government and User Agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order(s) & Hon'ble Court Order(s) pertaining to this project, if any, further time being in force, as applicable to the project.*



This has reference to the letter No. Z-29022/1/06-SSH (pt), dated 02.05.2008 of Director, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India and subsequent letters dated 13.10.2008, 14.11.2008 and 23.06.2009 seeking prior Environmental Clearance for the above project under the EIA Notification, 2006. The proposal has been appraised as per prescribed procedure in the light of provisions under the EIA Notification, 2006 on the basis of the mandatory documents enclosed with the application viz., the Questionnaire, EIA, EMP and the additional clarifications furnished in response to the observations of the Expert Appraisal Committee constituted by the competent authority in its meetings held on 26th - 28th June 2008, 19th - 20th November, 2008 and 18th - 19th June, 2009 and awarded "Silver" grading to the project.

2. It is, interalia, noted that the proposal involves construction of a 960 beds hospital including 50 private beds and medical college on a plot area of 40.5 ha. It is proposed to build only on 13.585 ha. in the first phase. The hospital complex will also include a cancer centre, teaching complex, auditorium, residential complex and public utility and infrastructure. The total water requirement is 1.52 MLD. Treated waste water to be used for flushing of toilets 600 KLD, AC cooling 600 KLD and horticulture purposes. During operation phase the total solid waste generation will be 1920 Kt/day. The waste will be treated and disposed as per the provisions of Bio-medical waste (Management and Handling Rules 1988). The power requirement is 1.241 MW. Total parking spaces proposed is for 875 cars, 10 taxi parking, 5 ambulance parking, 325 two wheeler parking and 200 cycle/cycle rickshaw parking. Total cost of the project is Rs. 289.65 Crores.

The Expert Appraisal Committee, after due consideration of the documents submitted by the project proponent and additional information furnished in response to its observations, have recommended for the grant of Environmental Clearance for the project mentioned above. Accordingly, the Ministry hereby accord necessary Environmental Clearance for the above project as per the provisions of Environmental Impact Assessment Notification - 2006 and its subsequent amendments, subject to strict compliance of the terms and conditions as follows:

PART A - SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

I. Construction Phase

- (i) "Consent for Establishment" shall be obtained from Orissa Pollution Control Board under Air and Water Act and a copy shall be submitted to the Ministry before start of any construction work at the site.
- (ii) Provision shall be made for the housing of construction labour within the site with all necessary infrastructure and facilities such as fuel for cooking, mobile toilets, mobile STP, safe drinking water, medical health care, crèche etc. The housing may be in the form of temporary structures to be removed after the completion of the project.
- (iii) A First Aid Room will be provided in the project both during construction and operation of the project.
- (iv) All the topsoil excavated during construction activities should be stored for use in horticulture/landscape development within the project site.
- (v) Disposal of muck during construction phase should not create any adverse effect on the neighbouring communities and be disposed taking the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people, only in approved sites with the approval of competent authority.
- (vi) Soil and ground water samples will be tested to ascertain that there is no threat to ground water quality by leaching of heavy metals and other toxic contaminants.
- (vii) Construction spoils, including bituminous material and other hazardous materials, must not be allowed to contaminate watercourses and the dump sites for such material must be secured so that they should not leach into the ground water.



hazardous waste generated during construction phase, should be disposed off as per applicable rules and norms with necessary approvals of the Orissa Pollution Control Board.

1. The diesel generator sets to be used during construction phase should be low sulphur diesel type and should conform to Environment (Protection) Rules prescribed for air and noise emission standards.

(i) The diesel required for operating DG sets shall be stored in underground tanks and if required, clearance from Chief Controller of Explosives shall be taken.

(ii) Vehicles hired for bringing construction material to the site should be in good condition and should have a pollution-check certificate and should conform to applicable air and noise emission standards and should be operated only during non-peak hours.

(iii) Ambient noise levels should conform to residential standards both during day and night. Incremental pollution loads on the ambient air and noise quality should be closely monitored during construction phase. Adequate measures should be made to reduce ambient air and noise level during construction phase, so as to conform to the stipulated standards by CPCB/OPCB.

(iv) Fly ash should be used as building material in the construction as per the provisions of Fly Ash Notification of September, 1999 and amended as on 27th August, 2003. (The above condition is applicable only if the project site is located within the 100 Km of Thermal Power Stations).

(v) Ready mixed concrete must be used in building construction.

(vi) Storm water control and its re-use as per CGWB and BIS standards for various applications.

(vii) Water demand during construction should be reduced by use of pre-mixed concrete, curing agents and other best practices referred.

(viii) Permission to draw ground water shall be obtained from the competent Authority prior to construction/operation of the project.

(ix) Separation of grey and black water should be done by the use of dual plumbing line for separation of grey and black water.


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
- (xix) Fixtures for showers, toilet flushing and drinking should be of low flow either by use of aerators or pressure reducing devices or sensor based control.
- (xx) Use of glass may be reduced by upto 40% to reduce the electricity consumption and load on air-conditioning. If necessary, use high quality double glass with special reflective coating in windows.
- (xxi) Roof should meet prescriptive requirement as per Energy Conservation Building Code by using appropriate thermal insulation material to fulfill requirement.
- (xxii) Opaque wall should meet prescriptive requirement as per Energy Conservation Building Code which is proposed to be mandatory for all air-conditioned spaces while it is aspirational for non-air-conditioned spaces by use of appropriate thermal insulation material to fulfill requirement.
- (xxiii) The approval of the competent authority shall be obtained for structural safety of the buildings due to earthquake, adequacy of fire fighting equipments, etc. as per National Building Code including protection measures from lightening etc.
- (xxiv) Regular supervision of the above and other measures for monitoring should be in place all through the construction phase, so as to avoid disturbance to the surroundings.
- (xxv) Under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, legal action shall be initiated against the project proponent if it was found that construction of the project has been started without obtaining environmental clearance.

II. Operation Phase

- i) The installation of the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) should be certified by an independent expert and a report in this regard should be submitted to the Ministry before the project is commissioned for operation. Treated affluent emanating from STP shall be recycled/reused to the maximum extent possible. Treatment of 100% grey water by decentralised treatment should be done. Discharge of unused treated affluent shall conform to the norms and standards of the Orissa Pollution Control Board. Necessary measures should be made to mitigate the odour problem from STP.
- ii) The solid waste generated should be properly collected and segregated. Wet garbage should be composted and dry / inert solid waste should be disposed off to the approved sites for land filling after recovering recyclable material.



- iii) Diesel power generating sets proposed as source of back up power for elevators and common area illumination during operation phase should be of enclosed type and conform to rules made under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. The height of stack of DG sets should be equal to the height needed for the combined capacity of all proposed DG sets. Use low sulphur diesel. The location of the DG sets may be decided with in consultation with Orissa Pollution Control Board.
- iv) Noise should be controlled to ensure that it does not exceed the prescribed standards. During night time the noise levels measured at the boundary of the building shall be restricted to the permissible levels to comply with the prevalent regulations.
- v) The green belt of the adequate width and density preferably with local species along the periphery of the plot shall be raised so as to provide protection against particulates and noise.
- vi) Weep holes in the compound walls shall be provided to ensure natural drainage of rain water in the catchment area during the monsoon period.
- vii) Rain water harvesting for roof run- off and surface run- off, as plan submitted should be implemented. Before recharging the surface run off, pre-treatment must be done to remove suspended matter, oil and grease. The borewell for rainwater recharging should be kept at least 5 mts. above the highest ground water table.
- viii) The ground water level and its quality should be monitored regularly in consultation with Central Ground Water Authority.
- ix) Traffic congestion near the entry and exit points from the roads adjoining the proposed project site must be avoided. Parking should be fully internalized and no public space should be utilized.
- x) A Report on the energy conservation measures confirming to energy conservation norms finalise by Bureau of Energy Efficiency should be prepared incorporating details about building materials & technology, R & U Factors etc and submit to the Ministry in three months time.
- xi) Energy conservation measures like installation of CFLs/TFLs for the lighting the areas outside the building should be integral part of the project design and should be in place before project commissioning. Use CFLs and TFLs should be properly collected and disposed off/sent for recycling as per the prevailing guidelines/ rules of the regulatory authority to avoid mercury contamination. Use of solar panels may be done to the extent possible.



- xii) Adequate measures should be taken to prevent odour problem from solid waste processing plant and STP.
- xiii) The building should have adequate distance between them to allow movement of fresh air and passage of natural light, air and ventilation.

PART - B. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- i) The environmental safeguards contained in the EIA Report should be implemented in letter and spirit.
- ii) The project proponent shall also submit six monthly reports on the status of compliance of the stipulated EC conditions including results of monitored data (both in hard copies as well as by e-mail) to the respective Regional Office of MoEF, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and the SPCB.

4. Officials from the Regional Office of MOEF, Bhubaneshwar who would be monitoring the implementation of environmental safeguards should be given full cooperation, facilities and documents / data by the project proponents during their inspection. A complete set of all the documents submitted to MoEF should be forwarded to the CCF, Regional office of MOEF, Bhubaneshwar.

5. In the case of any change(s) in the scope of the project, the project would require a fresh appraisal by this Ministry.

6. The Ministry reserves the right to add additional safeguard measures subsequently, if found necessary, and to take action including revoking of the environment clearance under the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, to ensure effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures in a time bound and satisfactory manner.

7. All other statutory clearances such as the approvals for storage of diesel from Chief Controller of Explosives, Fire Department, Civil Aviation Department, Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 etc. shall be obtained, as applicable by project proponents from the respective competent authorities.

8. These stipulations would be enforced among others under the provisions of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) act 1981, the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Public Liability (Insurance) Act, 1991 and EIA Notification, 2006.



9. The project proponent should advertise in at least two local Newspapers widely circulated in the region, one of which shall be in the vernacular language informing that the project has been accorded Environmental Clearance and copies of clearance letters are available with the Orissa Pollution Control Board and may also be seen on the website of the Ministry of Environment and Forests at <http://www.envfor.nic.in>. The advertisement should be made within 10 days from the date of receipt of the Clearance letter and a copy of the same should be forwarded to the Regional office of this Ministry at Bhubaneshwar.


10. Environmental clearance is subject to final order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Goa Foundation Vs. Union of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No.460 of 2004 as may be applicable to this project.

11. Any appeal against this Environmental Clearance shall lie with the National Environment Appellate Authority, if preferred, within a period of 30 days as prescribed under Section 11 of the National Environment Appellate Act, 1997.

12. A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zilla Parisad/Municipal Corporation, Urban Local Body and the Local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal. The clearance letter shall also be put on the website of the company by the proponent.

13. The proponent shall upload the status of compliance of the stipulated EC conditions, including results of monitored data on their website and shall update the same periodically. It shall simultaneously be sent to the Regional Office of MoEF, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and the SPCB. The criteria pollutant levels namely; SPM, RSPM, SO₂, NO_x (ambient levels as well as stack emissions) or critical sectoral parameters, indicated for the project shall be monitored and displayed at a convenient location near the main gate of the company in the public domain.

14. The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated to be submitted by the project proponent to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the company along with the status of compliance of EC conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional Offices of MoEF by e-mail.
