Subject: Diversion of 5.237 ha. of forest land in Sy. No. 92, 156, 157 & 159 of Marashettihalli village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumkur District for Construction of the proposed 110 KV D/C Narrow based Towers (KPTCL Design) for shifting of existing 110 KV S/C Nittur - Doddaguni lines at proposed HAL Factory land premises, near Bidarehalladakavalu village limits in favour of the Executive Engineer, Major Works Division, KPTCL, Tumkur District - reg.

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letter No No. FEE 6 FGL 2018 dated 07/02/2018 seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section'2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in respect of the above project. The in-principle (Stage-I) approval to the project was accorded by the Central Government vide letter of even number dated 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2018. The State Government vide letter No.FEE 06 FGL 2018 dated 22/12/2020 and 08/12/2022 have reported compliance to the conditions stipulated by the Central Government in the in-principle approval.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am directed to convey Central Government's final approval (**Stage-II**) under Section'2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 5.237 ha. of forest land in Sy. No. 92, 156, 157 & 159 of Marashettihalli village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumkur District for Construction of the proposed 110 KV D/C Narrow based Towers (KPTCL Design) for shifting of existing 110 KV S/C Nittur - Doddaguni lines at proposed HAL Factory land premises, near Bidarehalladakavalu village limits in favour of the Executive Engineer, Major Works Division, KPTCL, Tumkur District, subject to the following conditions:-

**A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to issue of final approval by State Government and handing over of forest land to User Agency:**

1. The conditions required to be adhered under Forests Right Act, 2006 as per the guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 shall be strictly complied with.
2. The State Government shall upload the KML file of the forest area diverted and CA area on the e-green watch portal with all requisite details.

**B. Conditions which need to be complied after handing over of forest land to the User Agency by the State Government:**

1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The demarcation of the forest area being diverted shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency.
3. Compensatory Afforestation (CA) over double the degraded forest land over an extent of 10.474 ha. of Manchaladore RF, in Sy.No. 110 of Hoovinakatte village, Gubbi Taluk, Tumkur District shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency. The State Government shall obtain prior permission of Central Government for change of location and schedule of compensatory afforestation, if any.
4. The additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency and the same shall be transferred to the designated Adhoc CAMPA Account.
5. Existing plantation in the right of way under the transmission line shall be maintained at the cost of the User Agency and dwarf species needs to be planted wherever possible.
6. Guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No. 7-25/2012 –FC dated 5/5/2014 for laying of transmission lines through forest areas shall be strictly followed.
7. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
8. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
9. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
10. No additional or new permanent paths will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
11. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
12. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
13. The forest area shall be used for the purpose for which it is granted. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 5.237 ha.
14. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.



15. The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Bangalore by the end of March every year; and
16. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wildlife.
17. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
18. The State Government and user agency shall comply the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
