Sub: Forest & Wildlife Department-Forest (Conservation) Act-Proposal for diversion of 0.1 ha of forest land in Kottiyoor Range of Kannur Forests Division for the reconstruction of Chekkupalam on Thalassery-Irikkur road, Kannur-reg

Ref: Letter No.FC1 – 1887/2019 dated 26.08.2019 from the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Management) & Nodal Officer Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

I am directed to forward herewith 3 hard copies of the proposal along with the required appendices, duly recommended, for the diversion of 0.1 ha of forest land under section (2) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in Kottiyoor Range of Kannur Forest Division for the reconstruction of Chekkupalam on Thalassery-Irikkur road, Kannur in favour of the Assistant Engineer, PWD, Bridge Section, Thalassery, for consideration and approval subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. Legal status of the forest shall remain unchanged.*
- 2. The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value as per the guidelines issued by Government of India.*
- 3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to pay additional Net*

Present Value if required.

4. Cost of raising of 10 times the number of trees to be felled shall be deposited by the User Agency.

5. The User Agency shall make payment of cost of Compensatory Afforestation, Net Present Value etc. as per the mode described. (forestclearance.nic.in)

6. The User Agency shall not fell any trees other than those marked for felling or cause damage to the surrounding forest & shall take all possible measures to conserve tree growth.

7. The User Agency shall not use the forest land for any purpose other than the purpose for which the forest land is diverted.

8. When the forest land is no longer required for the purpose, the land will be resumed back to the Forest Department.

9. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition imposed later on by Government of Kerala/Forest Department in the interest of Forest Conservation.

It is requested to kindly approve the above proposal and the decision in this regard may be communicated to this office at the earliest.
