The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State has submitted a proposal for diversion of 46.04 ha. Forest land for Penganga Open Cast Mining Project.

- 2. The Proposal for Penganga Opencast Mining Project has been initiated by Area General Manager, Western Coalfield Limited, Wani Area. The Government of India, Ministry of Coal, New Delhi has approved Penganga Open Cast Mine under coal bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 issued vide notification U/s 9(1) S.O. No. 2746, dated 29.10.2010 and published in Gazette of India, dt. 06.11.2010.
- 3. The Proposed project of Penganga Opencast mine will be supplying coal mainly to power plants of Maharashtra State, which caters the need of power supply in Vidarbha and other parts of Maharashtra State. Details of proposed forest land are as follows:-

- 4. Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur has certified that no alternative non forest land is possible and the forest land required is the barest minimum.
- 5. Area belongs to Eco-Value Class-III and category Open Forest of density below 0.4.
- 6. There are 516 trees of various species and girth in the area proposed for diversion.
- 7. The area involved does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary or Nature Reserve etc.
- 8. The project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archaeological or recreational importance.
- 9. The project has been accorded environmental clearance with conditions stipulated by Government of India vide its letter No. J-11015/46/2009-IA,II(M), Dated 31.01.2013.
- 10. The user agency has submitted the mining plan.
- 11. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur has certified that non forest areas covered under the project are not under the provision of Maharashtra Private forest (Acquisition) Act,1975 by virtue of application section 35 of Indian Forest Act,1927 and are not recognized as Deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "Forest" as per the dictionary meaning of Forest as intimated by Expert committee appointed under interim judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court, dated 12/12/1996.
- 12. There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 13. The proposed project is beyond 10 km. from the boundaries of Protected Areas.
- 14. The User Agency has given an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value.
- 15. The User Agency has agreed to defray the cost of Compensatory Afforestation over double degraded forest land.
- 16. The User Agency has submitted certificate under Schedule Tribes and other traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest rights) Act, 2006 issued by the District Collector, Chandrapur.
- 17. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Chanda Division, Chandrapur has given suitability certificate for 92.500 ha. degraded forest land of Comp. No. 152 Rampur Area 25.00 ha, Compt. No. 166 Somthana Area 25.00 ha., Compt. No. 170 Area 25.00 ha and Tulana Compt. No. 163 Area Tulana 17.50 ha. village of Rajura Range, Central Chanda Division, District-Chandrapur which to be proposed for Compensatory Afforestation land in lieu of Forest land required for the aforesaid project and it is suitable for afforestation and free from Encroachment and encumbrances.
- 18. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 19. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted for the non-forestry use on the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval

under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the same may please be obtained and communicated to this Government at earlier.
