I wish to state that, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Chennai has instruct to revise the Net Present Value based on the Vegetation furnished in Part II of Form A in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited. As per instruction of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Chennai, the revised amount of Net Present Value (NPV) payable by the User Agency in lieu of diversion of Forest Land is calculated as follows:-

1. The proposed area comes under the Eco-class of IV under category of ‘Open Forest’ and the NPV value prescribed for the above Eco-class is Rs.6,70,140/Ha as per the revised NPV rates communicated in the Government of India Ref.No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol I) dated:06.01.2022.

Rate of NPV for 1 Ha area = Rs.6,70,140/-

Therefore, for 0.24 Ha area = 0.24 Ha X Rs. 6,70,140/-  
Rs.1,60,834/-

2. The User Agency has to bear the additional amount of Net Present Value which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as fixed by Forest Department in future.
3. Amount of Net Present Value of forest area under the project shall be transferred / deposited to Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)

Only after receipt of compliance report it will be recommended for stage II clearance.
