It is to inform that, the Government has approved **(Stage-I)** for Diversion of **4.847 Ha** of forest land for improvement & widening of the existing road from **MRLO2 - PWD road at Mediguda to Maregaon** via Kothapally-G, Kunikasa, Paraswada -B of Gadiguda Mandal of Manikgarh RF of Adilabad Division of Adilabad District in favour of District Panchayath Raj Engineer, Adilabad of Adilabad District, duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied vide reference 1st cited and communicated by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests(HoFF), Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 2nd cited.

Further it is informed that, vide reference 2nd & 3rd cited, instructions have been issued for raise the demand to the user agency and mention correct account number for depositing the amount. Further PCCF(HoFF) & (CWW)(FAC) vide reference 3rd cited has issued instructions to raise the demand notice as per part IV for mitigation plan.

Accordingly, the undersigned vide reference 4th cited has raised Demand Notice to the User agency with a request to deposit an amount of Rs. 2,21,08,272/- into the concerned accounts and submit compliance on the Stage-I conditions.

Further, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad vide reference 5th cited has made certain changes in the mitigation plan and requested to issue Revised Demand Notice to the User agency

Accordingly, as per the instructions issued by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad vide reference 5th cited, the Revised Demand Notice is hereby issued and it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV, CC pillars and other charges as shown below.

The user agency shall follow the Guidelines regarding deposition of compensatory levies into Adhoc CAMPA account as shown below:

The User Agency will be directed to deposit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc. into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003, through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage I approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II approval.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

Further it is also informed that, this in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after 5 years.
