Please find, enclosed, herewith a proposal seeking forest clearance for diversion of 0.69 ha of Forest Land for construction of Playground at 15th Mile J.N. Road, Kyongnosla in Gangtok district of Sikkim by Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Govt. of Sikkim, Govt. of Sikkim.

Brief Description:

The user agency has proposed diversion of 0.69 ha of Forest Land for construction of Playground at 15th Mile J.N. Road, Kyongnosla in Gangtok district of Sikkim by Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Govt. of Sikkim, after obtaining the forest clearance under the provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

The proposal has since been uploaded in the "OMFC" portal of the Ministry vide proposal No. FP/SK/OTHERS/146127/2021 and accordingly transferred to the level of MoEF, Integrated Eastern Regional Office at Kolkata through on-line mode.

2. **Details of forest land proposed for diversion** – The total land involved under the project are as follows:

4. **Assessment of forest stock –**

- The forest area is situated under the Gangtok Territorial Division. The proposed project proposal **does not affect any trees and poles** however **100 Medicinal plants are affected** as per the enumeration lists enclosed.

5. **Flora and Fauna and archaeological importance –**

- The area does not form a part of National Park / WL Sanctuary or Biosphere Reserve, sample or preservation plot as per the information provided in Part-II, Sl. No. 7 (x) by Divisional Forest Officer, Gangtok.

6. **Compensatory Afforestation -**

The Compensatory Afforestation shall be maintained over an area in degraded forest land identified as under: -

The map showing the above identified forest land is enclosed at **Annexure –II** for reference.

The aforesaid degraded forest land is proposed to be brought under Afforestation programme as per the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme drawn by the Divisional Forest Officer, Gangtok Territorial Division with financial outlay of **Rs. 3,39,667.00** (Rupees three lakhs thirty-nine thousand six hundred sixty-seven) only (**Enclosed at Annexure III**). The Compensatory Afforestation Scheme will be undertaken in the designated compact area identified by Gangtok Territorial Division of Sikkim.


The Divisional Forest Officer (T) Gangtok Division has given the certificate on suitability of degraded forest land for Compensatory Afforestation. (Annexure –IV). Accordingly, the User Agency has furnished an undertaking to deposit the amount of CA, NPV and additional NPV if any etc. (Annexure – V), after Stage I clearance is granted by the Ministry in this respect. But no Penal Compensatory Afforestation has been imposed since no violation of the Act has been reported against.

No adverse comment has been given by any officers on the proposal and it has been suitably commented upon by senior officers. The proposed diversion site does not form a part of National Park, Biosphere Reserve, sample plot or preservation plot.

Therefore, it is requested you to accord approval under Section – 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for **diversion of 0.69 ha of Forest Land for construction of Playground at 15th Mile J.N. Road, Kyongnosla in Gangtok district of Sikkim by Sports & Youth Affairs Department, Govt. of Sikkim.**
