1. With reference to the subject and references cited above, it is informed that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Integrated Regional Office, Hyderabad vide reference 4th cite above has **accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval** for diversion of **1.0327 Ha** (revised from 1.3363 Ha) of Forest Land in Mancherial Division for Drinking Water Supply, Construction of 500 KLELMBR on Jalagutta (Hillocks) including approach road under Water supply Improvement Scheme (Mission Bhageeratha) in favour of Commissioner, Mancherial Municipality, Mancherial, **subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein** which has been communicated by the PrL.Chief Conservator of Forests TS Hyderabad vide reference 5th cited and requested the District Forest Officer Mancherial to raise the demand note as per the actual rates and submit the demand notice to the nodal Officer for vetting. Further Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, TS Hyderabad has informed that only after vetting of the demand note by the Nodal officer, the District Forest Officer/ Forest Divisional Officer should raise demand with the User Agency.

2. Accordingly, the demand as approved by the Nodal Officer (FCA) O/o PrLCCF, TS, Hyd vide reference 8th cited above is raised as follows to make payment of various compensatory levies.

a. The User Agency shall deposit an amount of **Rs.14,74,200/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Seventy Four thousand and Two hundred only)** in favour of Forest Divisional Officer, Mancherial PD **Ac.No.0112556358, Kotak Mahindra Bank, Branch: Mancherial, IFSC: KKBK0008367.**

- b. Further, the User Agency shall compulsorily deposit an amount of **Rs. 51,72,999 (Rupees Fifty One Lakhs Seventy Two thousand Nine hundred and Ninety Nine only)** towards cost of NPV CA, into Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account through the Ministry's Website i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA), O/o Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), TS, Hyderabad. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. 3. Further, the U/A is requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertaking etc., to the Forest Divisional Officer, Mancheri for submitting the remarks on condition wise compliance report to this office for onwards submission to the competent authority for issue Stage-II approval.
4. Further, the User Agency is also be requested comply with the following in accordance with the MoEF & CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.No. .4-TSB262/2022-HYD/423,Dt.06.04.2022 communicated vide PCCF., Hyderabad Re.No.12925/2020/FCA-1, Dt: 07.04.2022.
 - a) Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purpose in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper i.e., one is vernacular language and the other in English.
 - b) The copies of the clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.
5. Further, the User Agency is requested to furnish undertakings on C.No. i, iv, v, vii, viii, ix, xi, xii, xiii, xiv, xv, xvi, xvii, xviii & xix
6. The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

In view of the above, the Commissioner, Mancheri Municipality, Mancheri is requested to submit the compliance report as per the above for taking further course of action in the matter.
